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## GASOLINE REPORT

### Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 7, 2010.

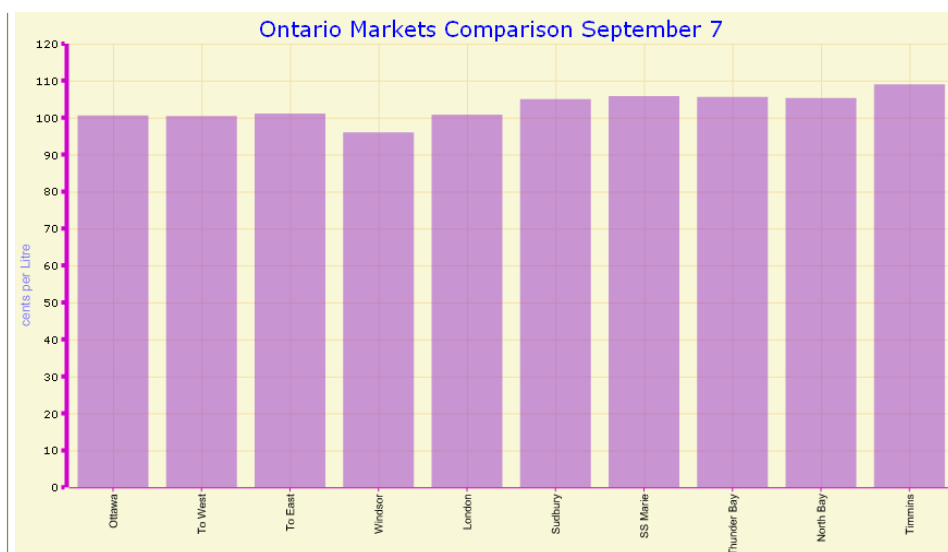
**The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline, after rising two straight weeks, declined by 0.1 cents to 101.0 cents a litre.**

Prices fell by 1.5 cents in London, 1.2 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low), and less than a cent in Toronto and Timmins (the latter to a two-month low). Prices increased by 6.6 cents in North Bay (from a three-month low), 4.3 cents in Sudbury (from a two-month low), 3.3 cents in Windsor (from a two-month low), 2.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a two-month low), and 0.6 cents in Ottawa. Windsor had the lowest average price for the ninth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario, after narrowing two straight weeks, widened to 5.3 cents from a five-month low of 2.8 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.1 cents to 99.4 cents, a four-week high.

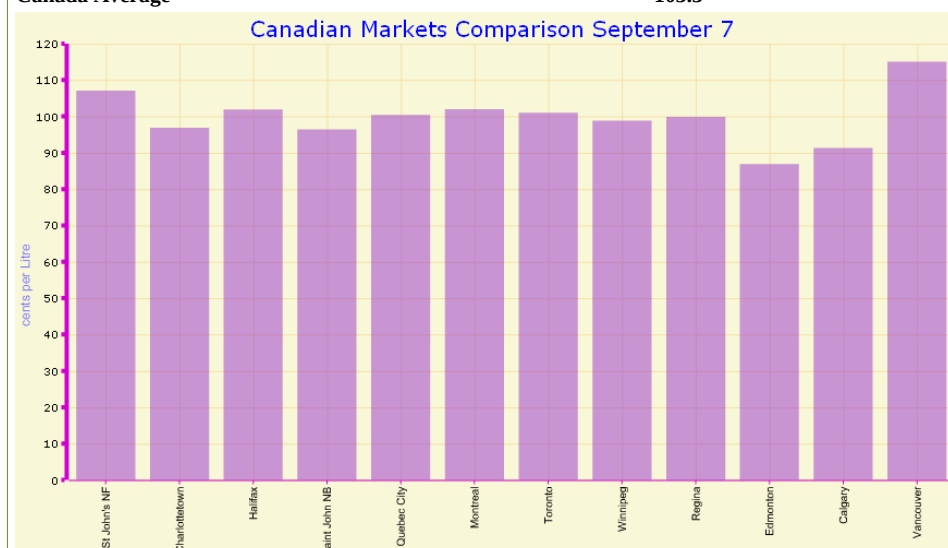
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after rising two straight weeks, declined by 2.0 cents to 101.3 cents, a three-month low. Prices fell by 7.0 cents in Montreal, 2.0 cents in Quebec City (to a three-month low), 1.4 cents in Toronto, 1.2 cents in Vancouver (to a three-month low), and less than a cent in Edmonton and Calgary. Prices rose by 2.0 cents in Halifax and 1.8 cents in both St. John's (from a ten-month low) and Saint John (from an eight-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.3 cents to 99.8 cents, a four-month high.

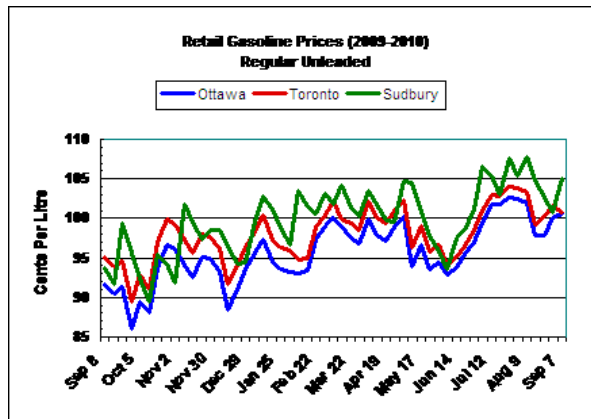
