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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 13, 2010.

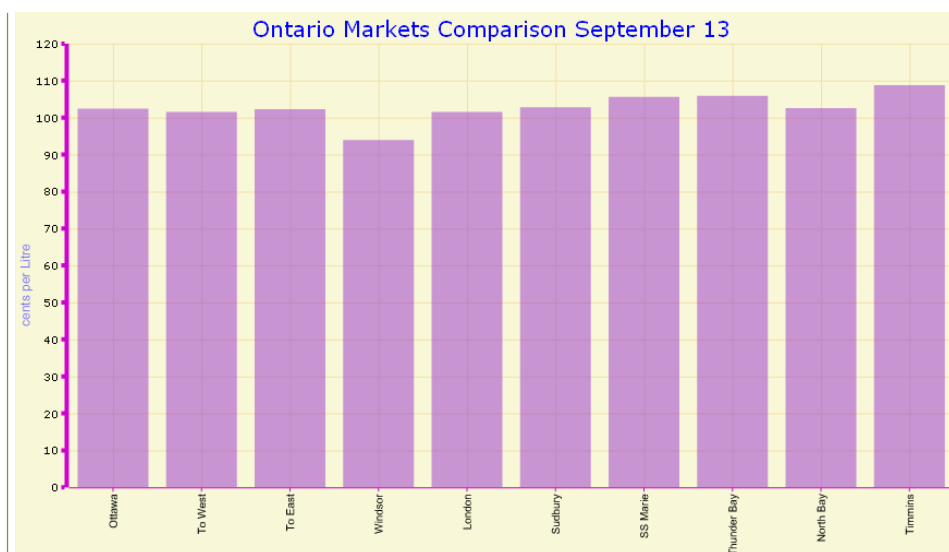
Despite a slight dip in domestic wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased by 0.9 cents to 101.9 cents a litre, a five-week high.

Prices rose by 1.8 cents in Ottawa, 1.2 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in London and Thunder Bay (the latter from a two-month low). Prices fell by 2.7 cents in North Bay, 2.2 cents in Sudbury, 2.1 cents in Windsor, and less than a cent in Sault Ste. Marie and Timmins (the latter to a three-month low). Windsor had the lowest average price for the tenth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from 5.3 cents to 3.2 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing two straight weeks, was unchanged at 99.4 cents.

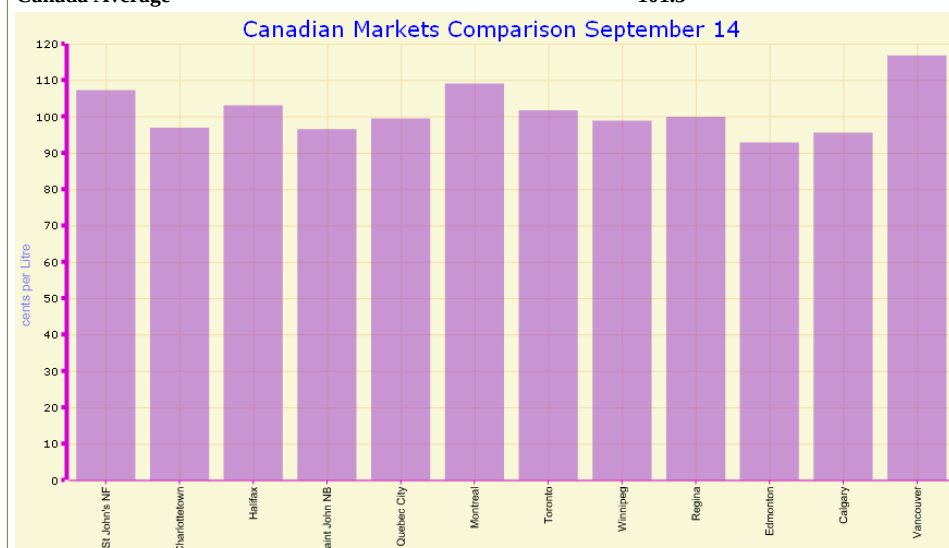
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 2.5 cents from a three-month low to 103.8 cents, a five-week high. Prices rose by 7.0 cents in Montreal, 5.9 cents in Edmonton, 4.2 cents in Calgary, 1.8 cents in Vancouver (from a three-month low), 1.1 cents in Halifax, and less than a cent in Toronto, St. John's, and Saint John. Prices fell by 1.0 cents in Quebec City (to a three-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.3 cents to 100.1 cents, a four-month high.

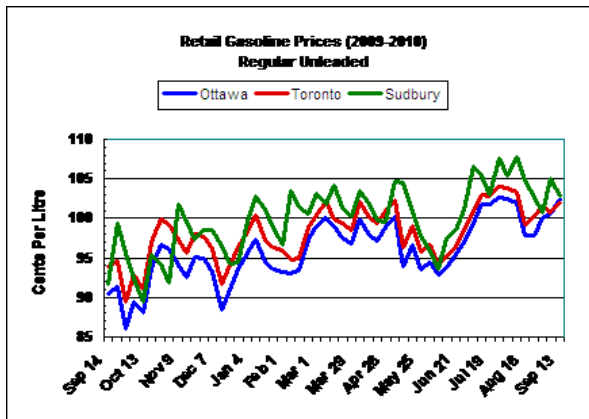
