Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 20, 2010.

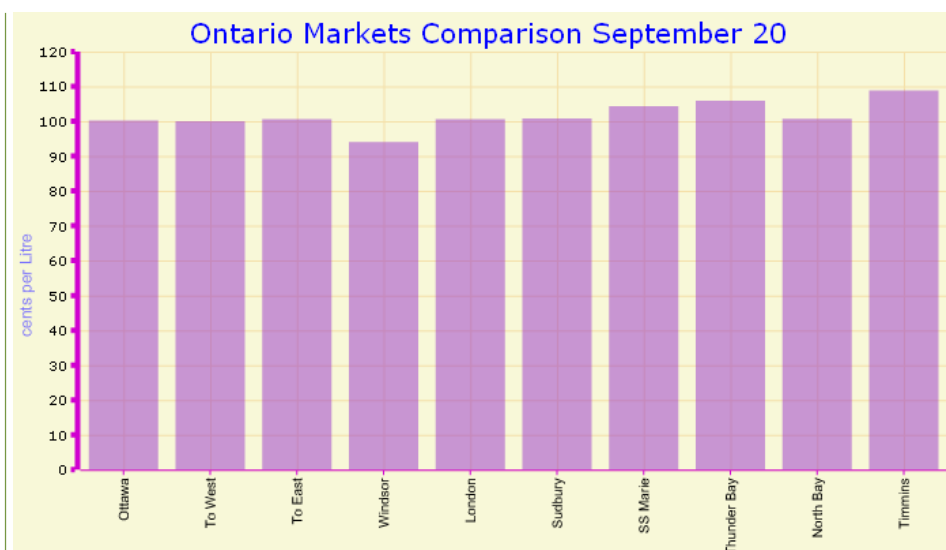
Moderate discounting in some markets and slightly lower wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline by 1.5 cents to 100.4 cents a litre, a four-week low.

Prices fell by 2.2 cents in Ottawa, 2.0 cents in Sudbury, 1.9 cents in North Bay, 1.6 cents in Toronto, 1.3 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, and 0.9 cents in London. Prices rose by 0.1 cents in Windsor, but were still the lowest on average for the eleventh straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened slightly from 3.2 cents to 3.7 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased by 0.3 cents to 99.7 cents, a six-week high.

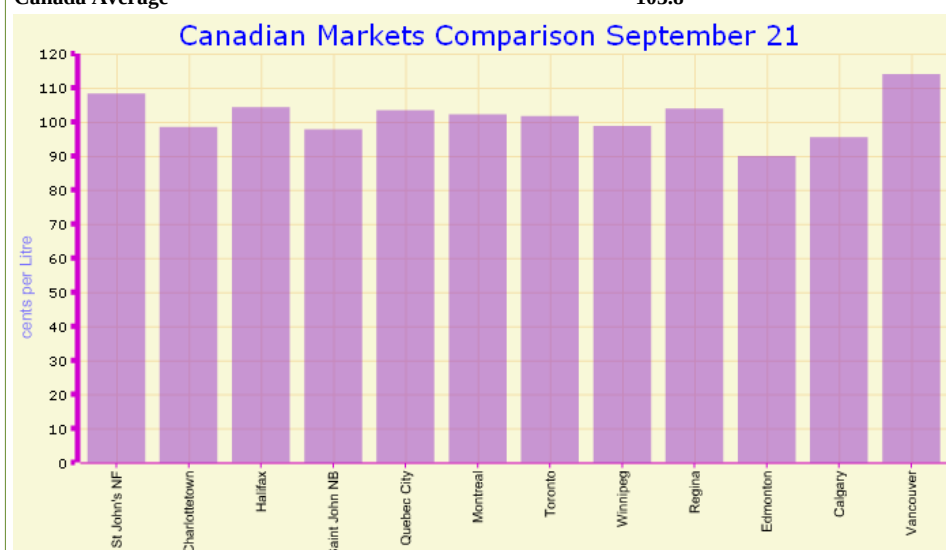
The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 1.4 cents from a five-week high to 102.4 cents. Prices fell by 6.8 cents in Montreal, 2.9 cents in Edmonton, and 2.8 cents in Vancouver (to a three-month low). Prices rose by 4.0 cents in both Quebec City (from a three-month low) and Regina (to a four-month high), 1.6 cents in Charlottetown, 1.3 cents in both Halifax and Saint John, and 1.1 cents in St. John's. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the fourth straight week, by 0.2 cents to 100.3 cents, a four-month high.

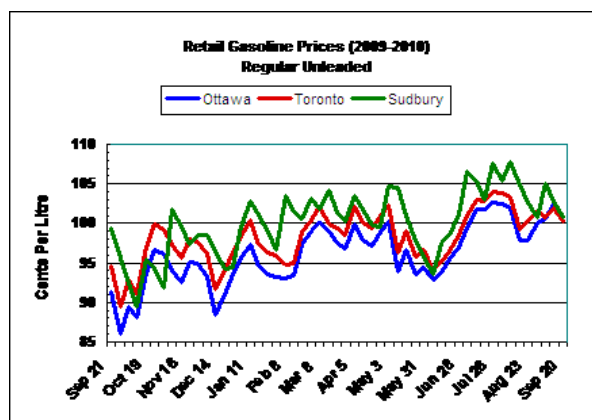
