Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 25, 2010.

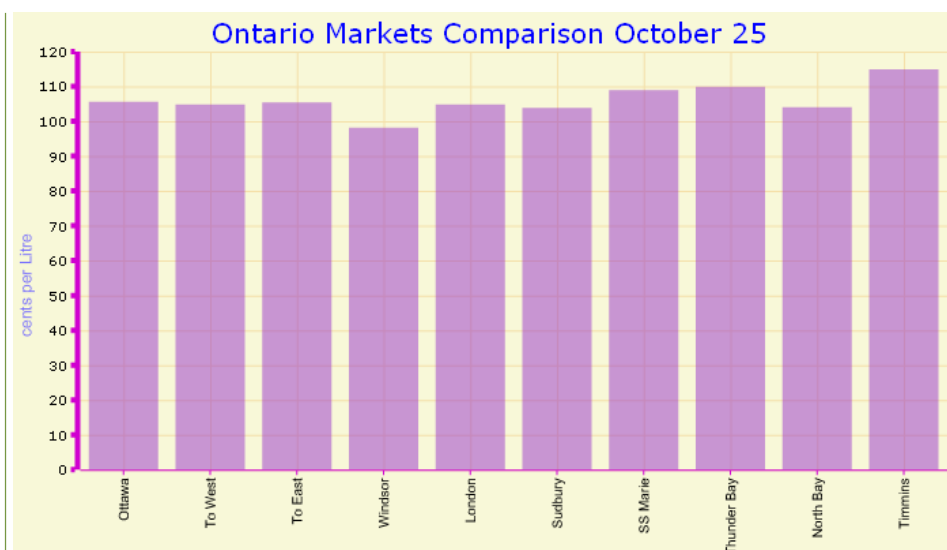
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.2 cents to 105.1 cents a litre as North American wholesale prices fell despite a slight increase in world crude oil prices.

Prices fell by 2.6 cents in Windsor (from a 24-month high), 2.0 cents in Sudbury, 1.9 cents in North Bay, and less than a cent in Ottawa, Thunder Bay (from a 24-month high), and Toronto West. Prices rose by 3.2 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a 24-month high), Timmins (to a 24-month high), and less than a cent in Toronto East and London. Windsor had the lowest average price for the sixteenth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario was unchanged at 2.7 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the fourth straight week, by 0.2 cents to 104.3 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

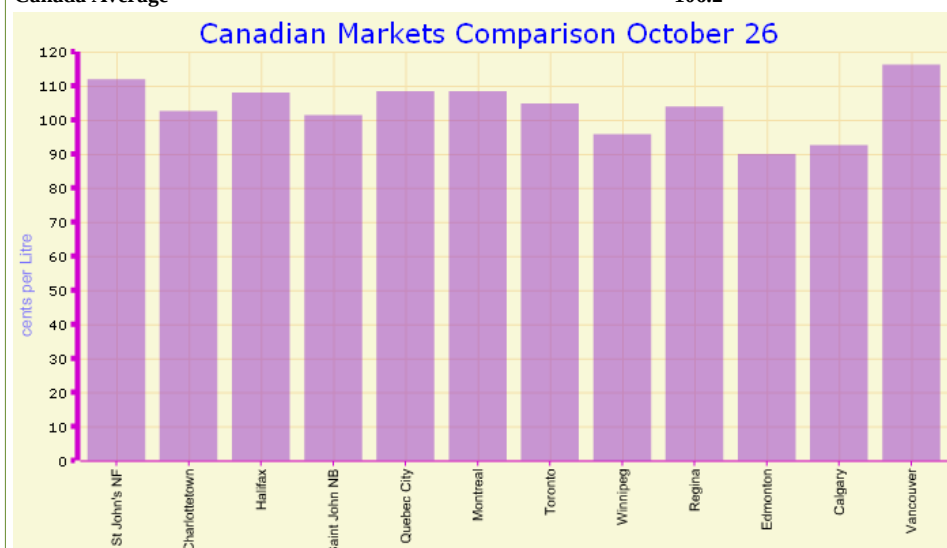
The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 1.3 cents from a 24-month high to 104.9 cents, a four-week low . Prices fell by 3.8 cents in Calgary (to a two-month low), 3.2 cents in Toronto (from a 25-month high), 2.1 cents in Halifax, 1.5 cents in St. John's (from a five-month high), and 1.4 cents in Saint John (from a five-month high). Prices rose by 1.8 cents in Montreal and 1.4 cents in Vancouver. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after rising eight straight weeks, was unchanged at a 23-month high of 105.3 cents.

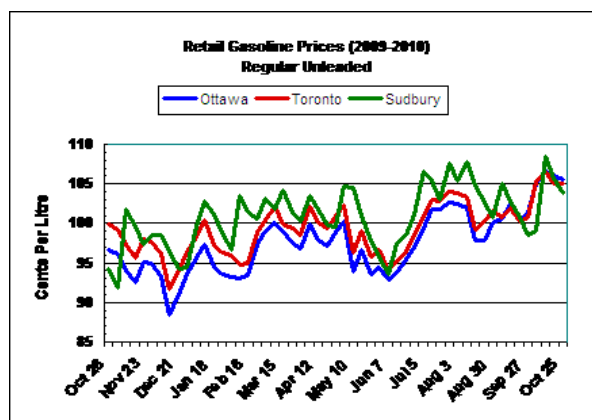
