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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 1, 2010.

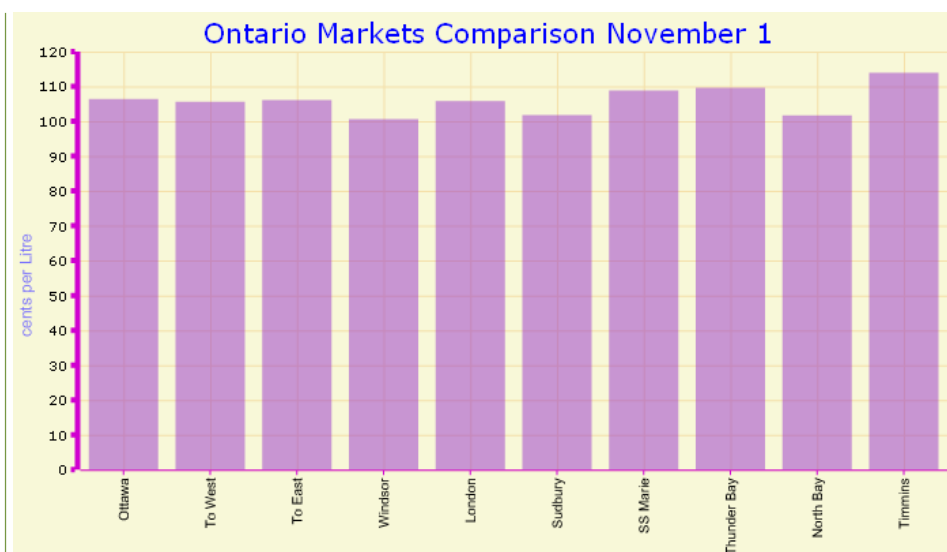
Higher prices in southern Ontario offset lower prices in the north, causing the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 0.6 cents to 105.7 cents a litre.

Prices rose by 2.5 cents in Windsor, 1.0 cents in London, and less than a cent in Ottawa and Toronto. Prices fell by 2.3 cents in North Bay, 2.0 cents in Sudbury, 1.0 cents in Timmins (from a 24-month high), and less than a cent in Thunder Bay and Sault Ste. Marie (the latter from a 24-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the seventeenth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from 2.7 cents to 0.7 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing four straight weeks, declined by 0.1 cents from a 23-month high to 104.2 cents.

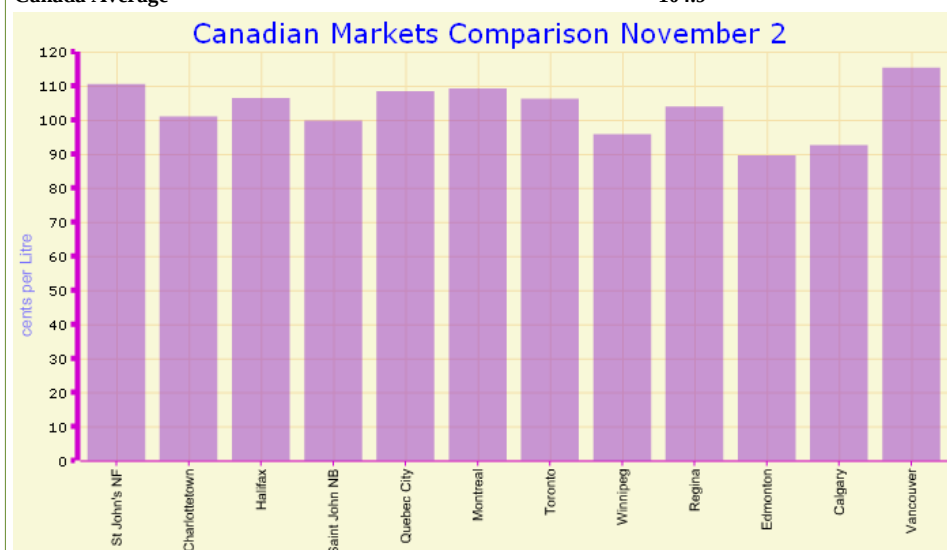
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.5 cents from a four-week low to 105.4 cents. Prices rose by 1.4 cents in Toronto and 0.8 cents in Montreal, but fell by 1.6 cents in Saint John, Halifax, and Charlottetown, 1.4 cents in St. John's, and less than a cent in Vancouver and Edmonton. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined by 0.6 cents from a 23-month high to 104.7 cents.

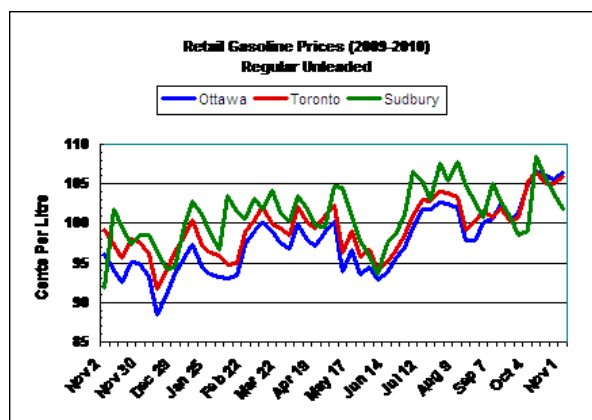
