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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 8, 2010.

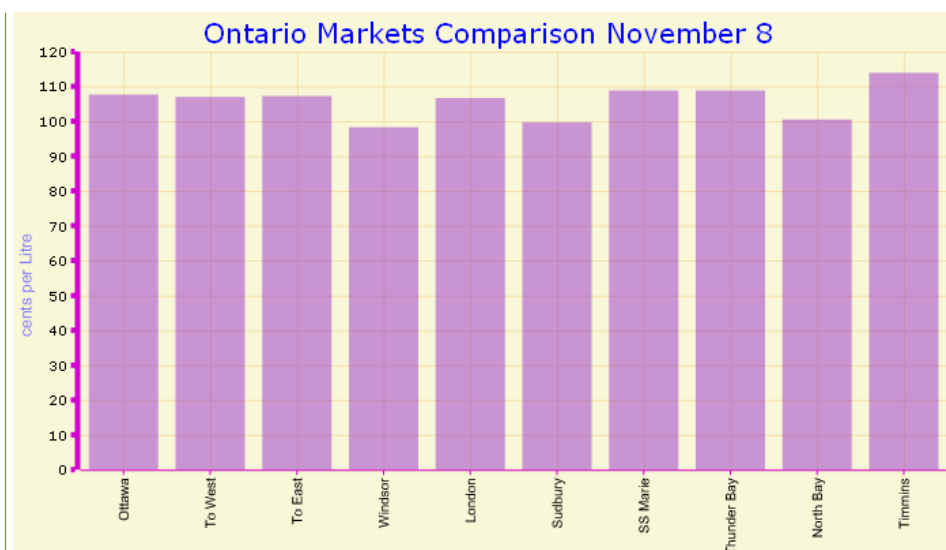
World crude oil prices of nearly \$87 a barrel and higher North American wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase for the second straight week, by 0.8 cents to 106.5 cents a litre, its highest level since October 2008.

Prices rose by 1.3 cents in Toronto, 1.2 cents in Ottawa, and 0.9 cents in London (all to a 25-month high). Prices fell by 2.4 cents in Windsor, 2.1 cents in Sudbury, 1.2 cents in North Bay, and 0.8 cents in Thunder Bay (the latter from a 24-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the eighteenth straight week. For the second time in five weeks, the average price in northern Ontario was lower than in the south, to the tune of 1.4 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased by 1.9 cents to 106.1 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

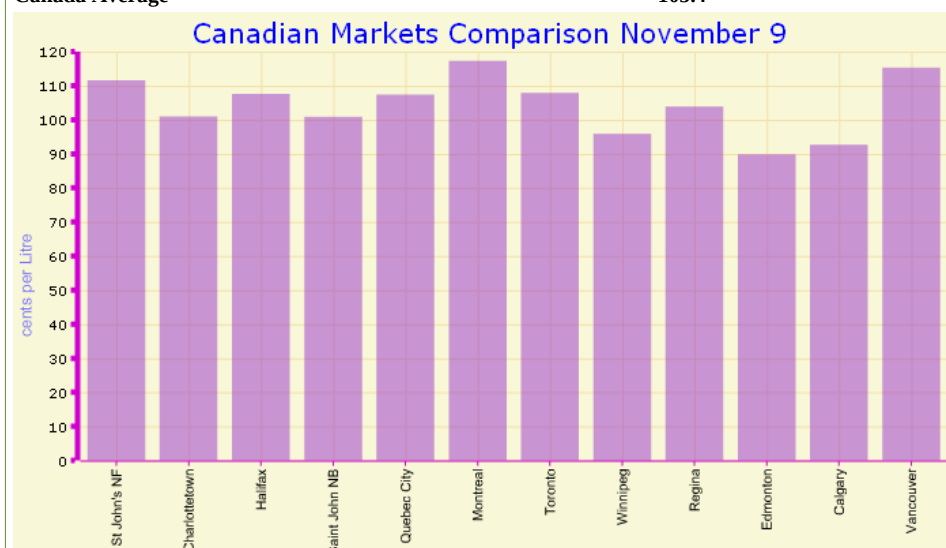
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the second straight week, by 2.4 cents to 107.8 cents, its highest level since October 2008. Prices rose by 8.1 cents in Montreal (to a 25-month high), 1.7 cents in Toronto, 1.2 cents in Halifax, 1.1 cents in both Saint John and St. John's, and less than a cent in Edmonton, Calgary, and Winnipeg. Prices fell by 1.0 cents in Quebec City. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased by 2.8 cents to 107.5 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

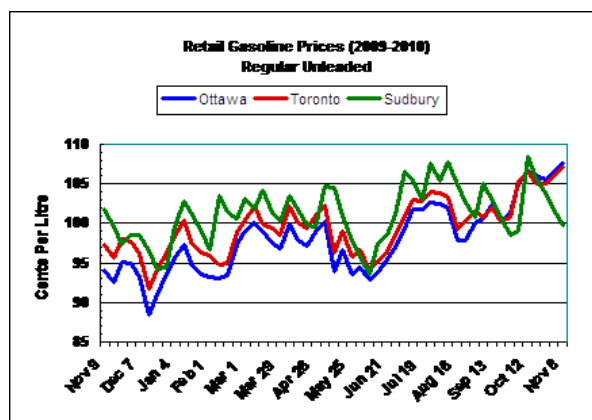
