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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 22, 2010.

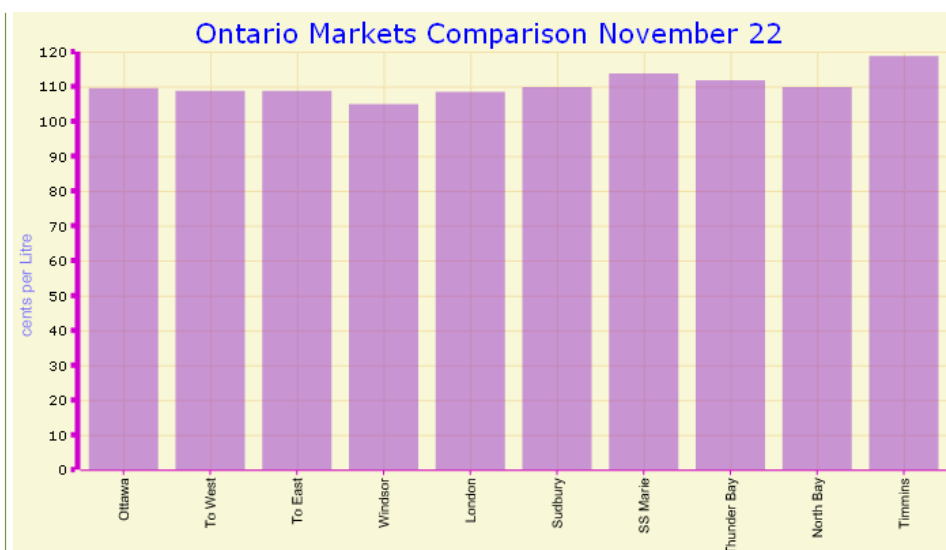
Despite higher wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 1.9 cents from a 26-month high to 109.9 cents a litre, ending a string of three consecutive weekly increases.

Prices fell by 2.6 cents in Toronto (from a 26-month high), 2.2 cents in Ottawa (from a 26-month high), 2.0 cents in London (from a 26-month high), 2.0 cents in Sudbury (from a 25-month high), and 2.0 cents in North Bay (from a 25-month high). Prices rose by 2.8 cents in Windsor, 1.8 cents in Timmins, and 0.1 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (all to a 26-month high). Despite its increase, Windsor had the lowest average price for the 20th straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 1.7 cents to 3.2 cents, a two-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.4 cents to 108.6 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

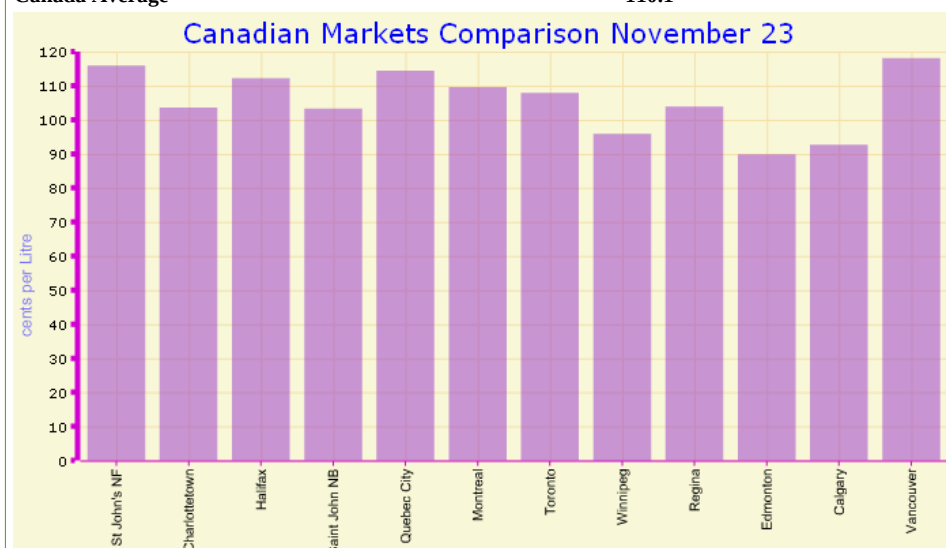
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 3.3 cents from a 25-month high to 106.8 cents. Prices fell by 11.5 cents in Montreal and 3.5 cents in Toronto (both from a 26-month high). Prices rose by 3.0 cents in St. John's (to a 25-month high), 2.8 cents in Halifax (to a 26-month high), 2.1 cents in Saint John (to a six-month high), 1.3 cents in Vancouver (to a three-month high), and 0.9 cents in Edmonton. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.4 cents to 109.9 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

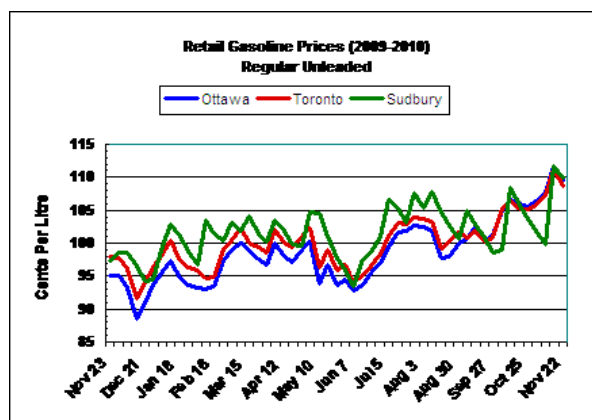
