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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending November 29, 2010.

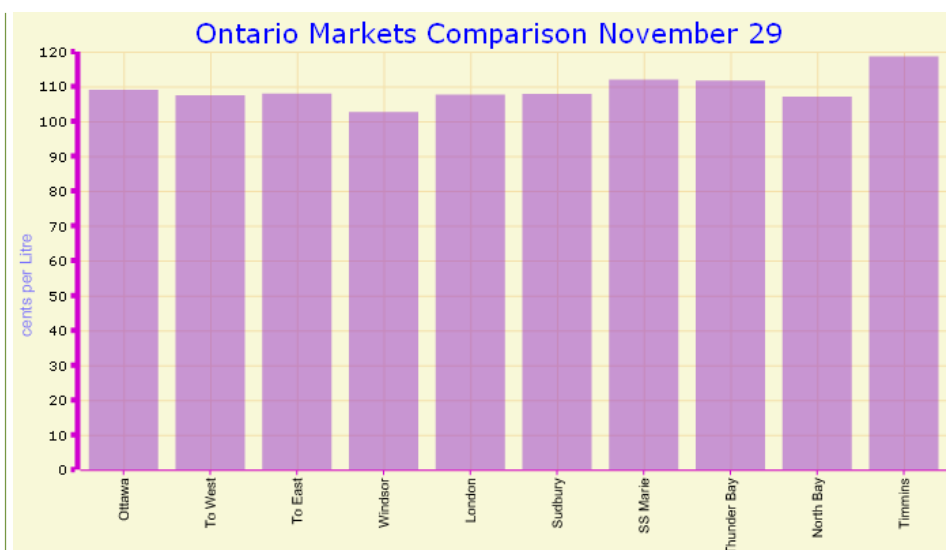
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the second straight week, by 1.0 cents to 108.0 cents a litre, reflecting lower domestic wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 2.7 cents in North Bay, 2.2 cents in Windsor (from a 26-month high), 2.0 cents in Sudbury, 1.7 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a 26-month high), 1.0 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in London, Ottawa, Thunder Bay, and Timmins (the latter from a 26-month high). Windsor had the lowest average price for the 21st straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed to 2.8 cents from a two-month high of 3.2 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.9 cents from a 25-month high to 107.7 cents.

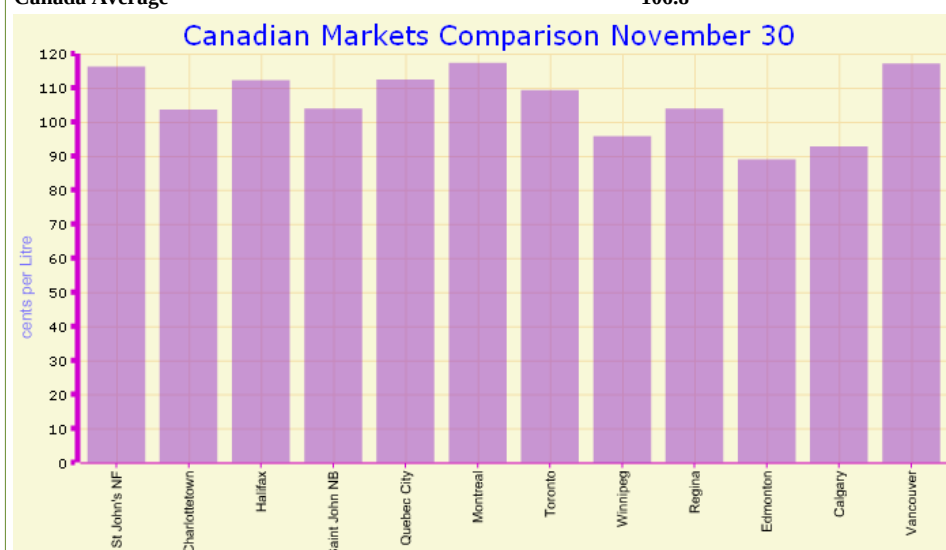
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 2.0 cents to 108.8 cents. Prices rose by 7.7 cents in Montreal, 1.4 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in Saint John (to a seven-month high), St. John's (to a 25-month high), and Calgary. Prices fell by 2.0 cents in Quebec City, 1.0 cents in Vancouver (from a three-month high), Edmonton, and Winnipeg. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.3 cents from a 24-month high to 109.6 cents.

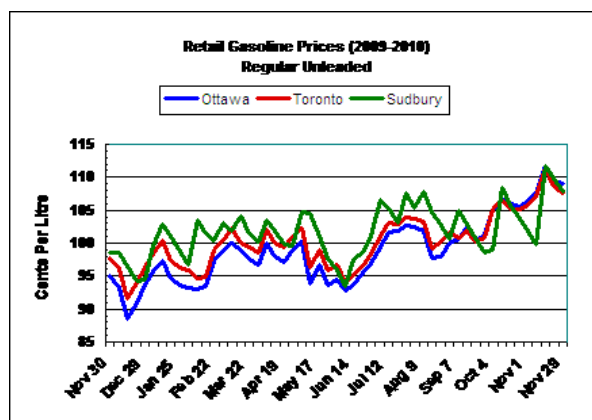
