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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending December 13, 2010.

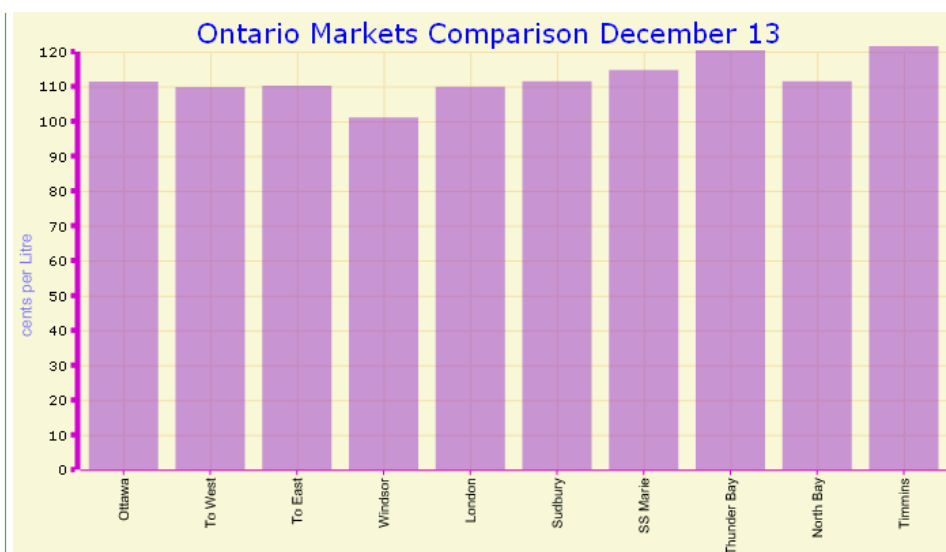
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 1.6 cents from a 26-month high to 110.4 cents a litre, reflecting lower world crude oil and North American wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 1.7 cents in Toronto, 1.4 cents in both London and Thunder Bay, 1.2 cents in North Bay, 1.1 cents in Ottawa, and less than a cent in Sudbury and Sault Ste. Marie (all from a 26-month high). Prices in Windsor fell by 2.8 cents, and were the lowest in our survey for the 23rd straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the second straight week, to 5.8 cents, a four-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 3.7 cents to 111.1 cents, its highest level since October 2008.

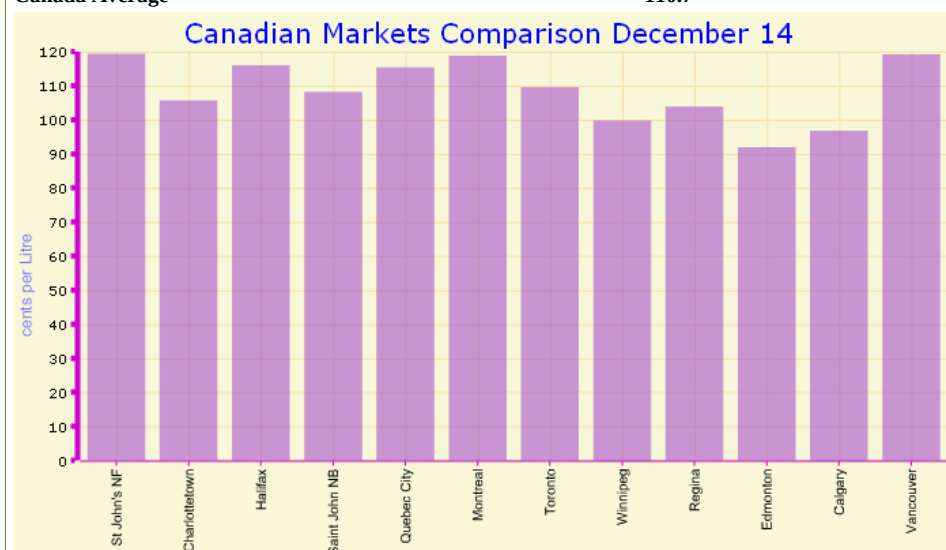
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 0.3 cents from a 26-month high to 110.4 cents. Prices fell by 3.0 cents in Edmonton (from a seven-month high), 1.7 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in Quebec City (from a 26-month high), Vancouver (from a 26-month high), and Calgary (from a seven-month high). Prices rose by 4.5 cents in Saint John (to a 26-month high), 3.6 cents in St. John's (to a 26-month high), 1.7 cents in Halifax (to a 26-month high), 1.0 cents in Winnipeg (to a 13-month high), and 0.8 cents in Montreal. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 1.2 cents to 111.7 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

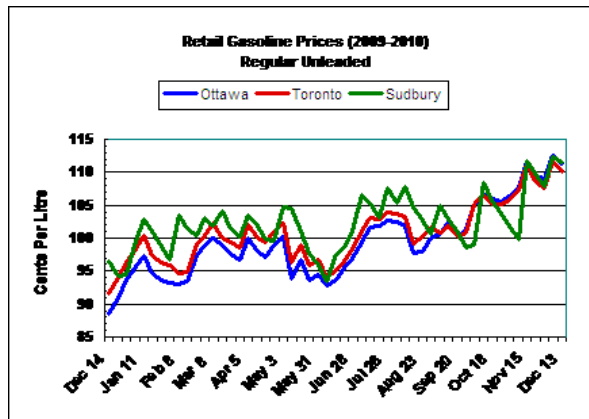
