Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending December 20, 2010.

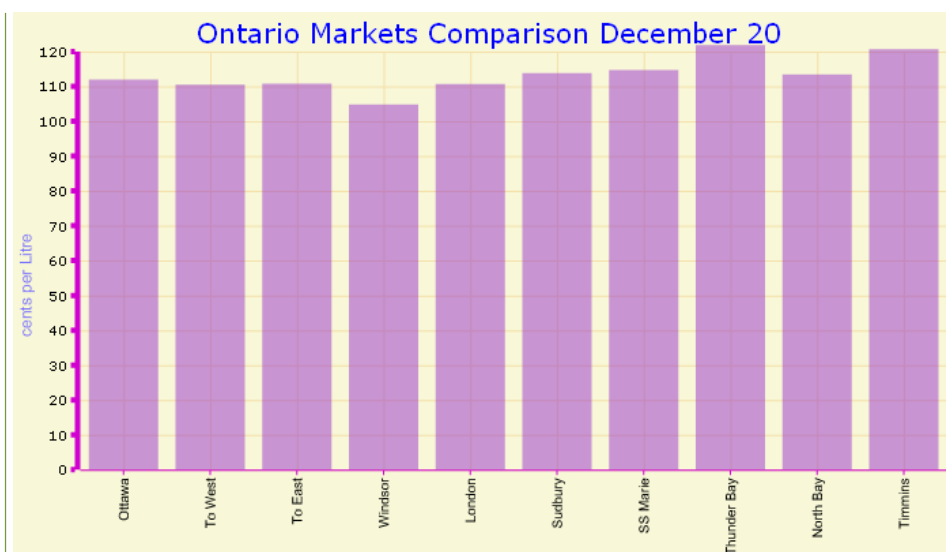
Despite lower domestic wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased slightly, by 0.9 cents to 111.3 cents a litre.

Prices rose by 3.7 cents in Windsor, 2.3 cents in Sudbury (to a 26-month high), 1.9 cents in North Bay (to a 26-month high), 1.5 cents in Thunder Bay (to a 26-month high), and less than a cent in London, Toronto, and Ottawa. Prices fell by 0.9 cents in Timmins. Windsor had the lowest average price for the 24th straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the third straight week, from 5.8 cents to 6.3 cents, a four-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.6 cents to 111.7 cents, its highest level since October 2008.

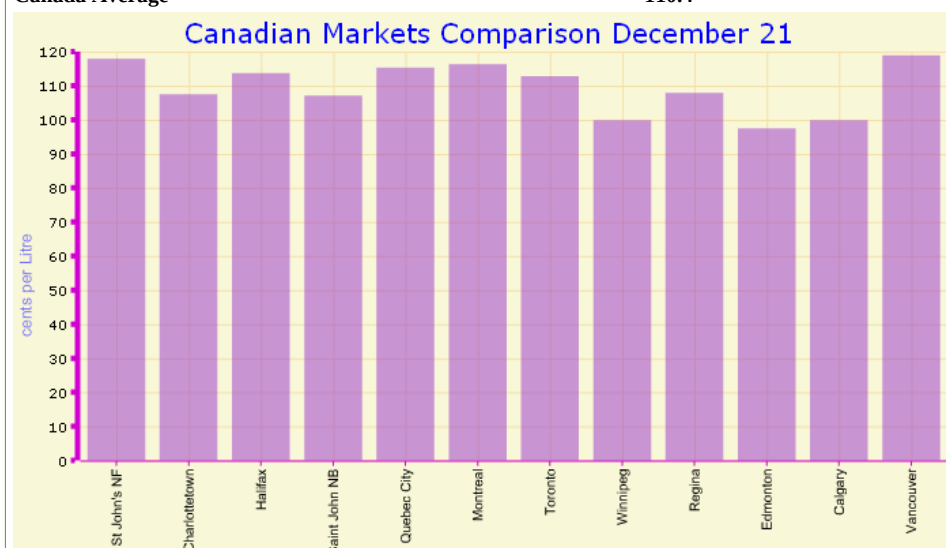
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 1.3 cents to 111.7 cents, a 26-month high. Prices rose by 5.6 cents in Edmonton (to a 26-month high), 4.0 cents in Regina (to a seven-month high), 3.2 cents in Toronto (to a 27-month high), 3.1 cents in Calgary (to a 26-month high), 1.8 cents in Charlottetown (to a 26-month high), and 0.1 cents in Winnipeg (to a 13-month high). Prices fell by 2.5 cents in Montreal, 2.3 cents in Halifax (from a 26-month high), 1.5 cents in St. John's (from a 26-month high), 1.1 cents in Saint John (from a 26-month high), and less than a cent in Vancouver and Quebec City. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.8 cents to 112.5 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

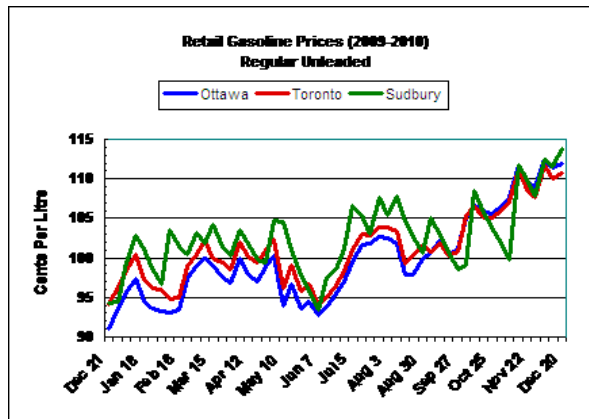
