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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 17, 2011.

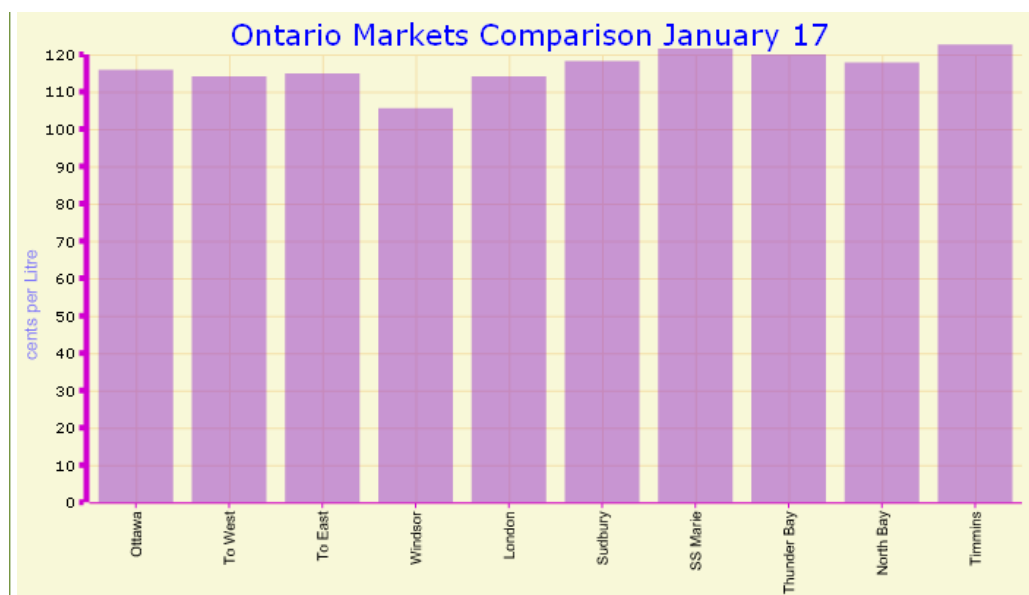
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline, after declining two straight weeks, increased by 1.7 cents to 114.9 cents a litre, its highest level since September 2008.

Prices rose by 2.7 cents in Sudbury (to a 27-month high), 2.5 cents in North Bay (to a 27-month high), 2.1 cents in Toronto (to a 28-month high), 1.9 cents in Ottawa (to a 28-month high), and 1.8 cents in London (to a 28-month high). Prices fell by 2.6 cents in Windsor (from a 27-month high) and 0.1 cents in Timmins. Windsor had the lowest average price for the 28th straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed slightly to 5.3 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the sixth straight week, by 1.7 cents to 115.4 cents, its highest level since October 2008.

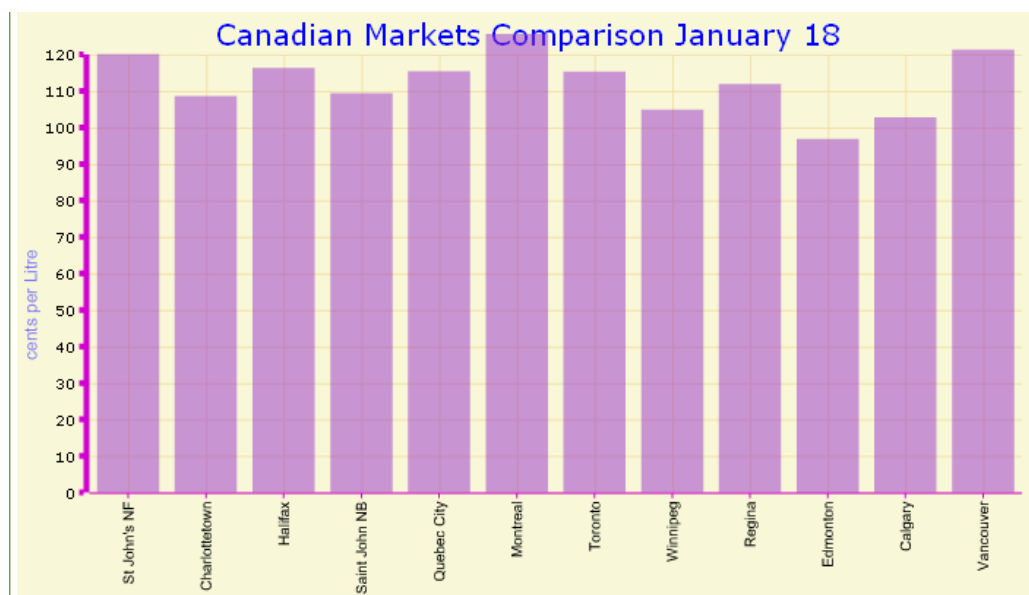
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 2.5 cents to 115.6 cents, its highest level since September 2008. Prices rose by 8.0 cents in Montreal (to a 28-month high), 2.8 cents in Vancouver (to a 27-month high), 1.7 cents in Toronto (to a 28-month high), and 0.1 cents in Regina (to a 27-month high). Prices fell by 2.0 cents in Edmonton and less than a cent in Calgary and Saint John. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the seventh straight week, by 2.0 cents to 116.0 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

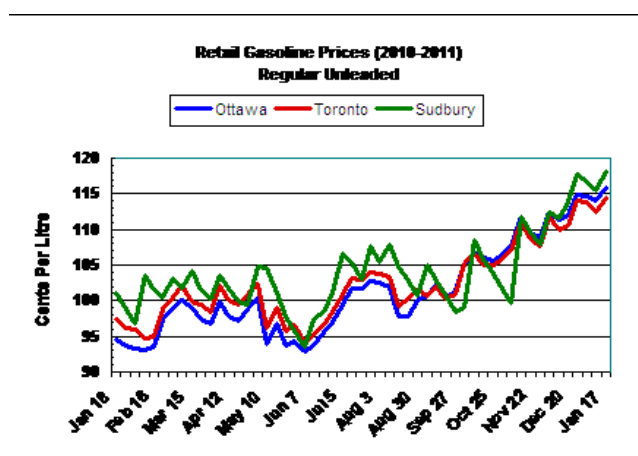
