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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending January 24, 2011.

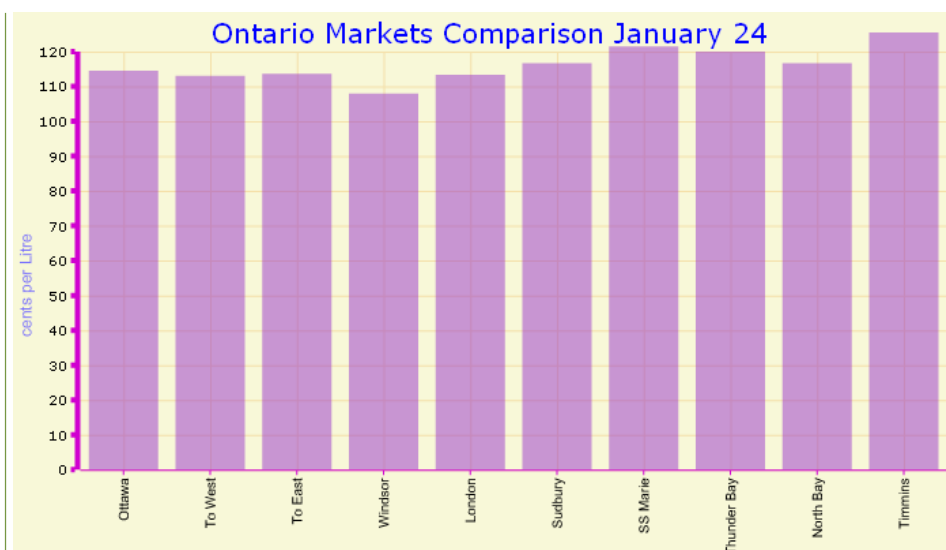
Although domestic wholesale prices rose slightly, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined this week, by 1.0 cents from a 28-month high to 113.9 cents a litre.

Prices fell by 1.5 cents in Sudbury (from a 27-month high), 1.4 cents in Ottawa (from a 28-month high), 1.2 cents in Toronto (from a 28-month high), 1.1 cents in North Bay (from a 27-month high), and less than a cent in London (from a 28-month high) and Sault Ste. Marie. Prices rose by 2.9 cents in Timmins (to a 28-month high) and 2.3 cents in Windsor. Despite its increase, Windsor had the lowest average price for the 29th straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 5.3 cents to 6.0 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the seventh straight week, by 1.8 cents to 117.2 cents, its highest level since October 2008.

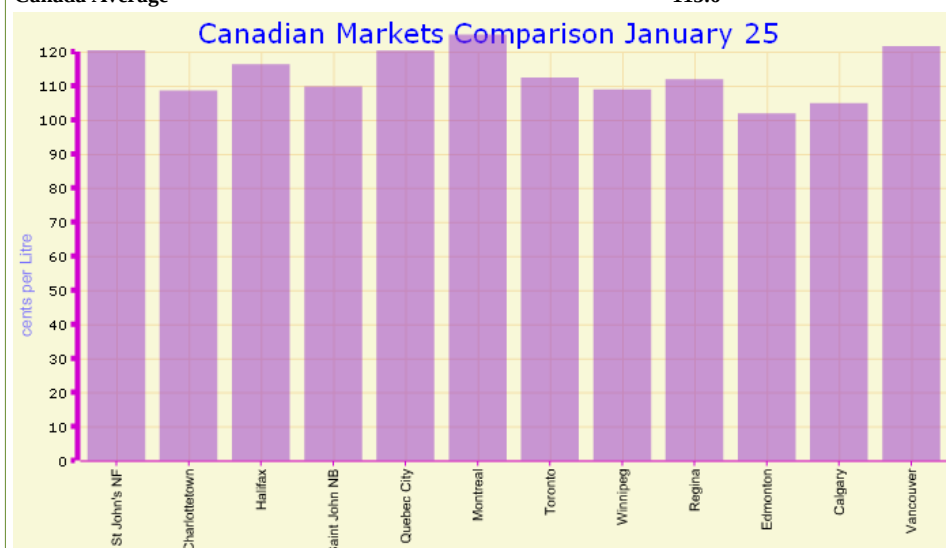
The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.7 cents from a 28-month high to 114.9 cents. Prices fell by 2.9 cents in Toronto and 0.6 cents in Montreal (both from a 28-month high). Prices rose by 5.0 cents in Edmonton, 4.9 cents in Quebec City (to a 28-month high), 4.0 cents in Winnipeg (to a 27-month high), 2.1 cents in Calgary, and less than a cent in Saint John, St. John's, and Vancouver (the latter to a 28-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the eighth straight week, by 0.1 cents to 116.1 cents, its highest level since November 2008.

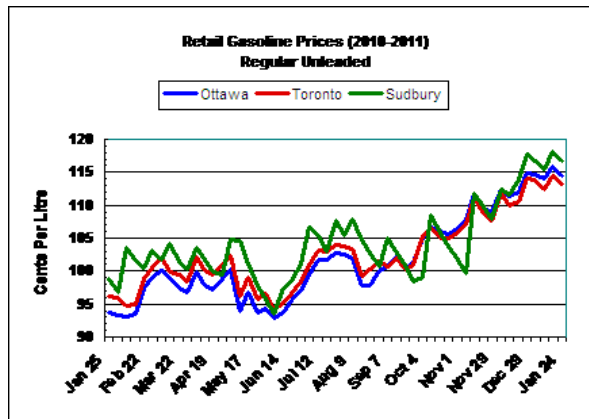
