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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending February 14, 2011.

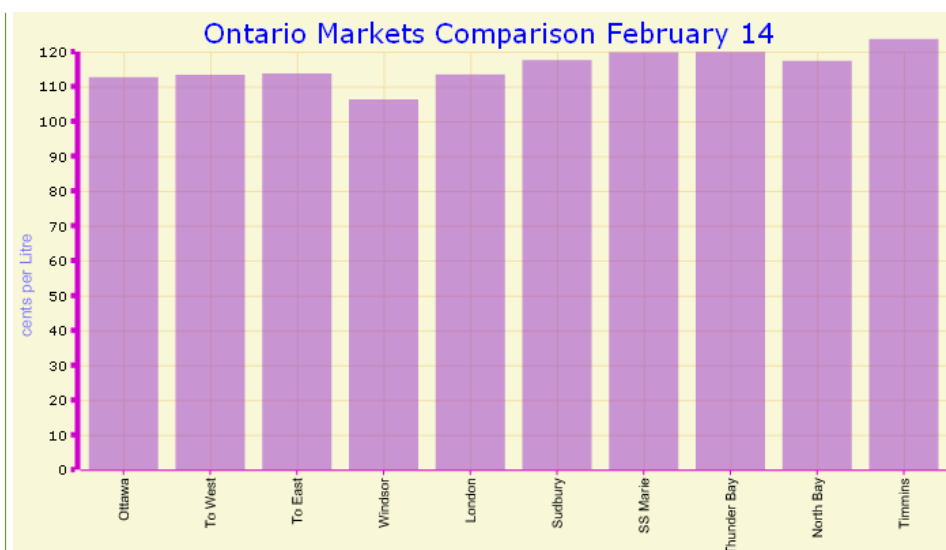
Higher prices in Toronto and London offset lower prices elsewhere, causing the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 0.6 cents from a two-month low to 113.6 cents a litre.

Prices rose by 1.5 cents in London and 1.4 cents in Toronto (both from a two-month low), but fell by 3.0 cents in Windsor (from a 28-month high), 1.4 cents in North Bay (from a 28-month high), 1.2 cents in Sudbury (from a 28-month high), and less than a cent in Ottawa (from a two-month high), Timmins, and Thunder Bay. Windsor had the lowest average price for the 32nd straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from a nine-month high of 7.6 cents to 6.2 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the tenth straight week, by 1.4 cents to 120.4 cents, its highest level since September 2008.

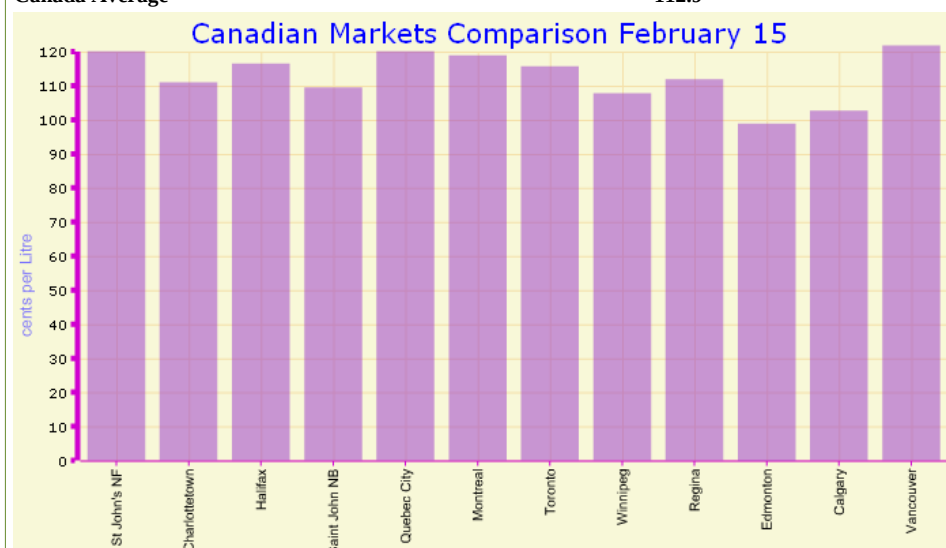
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after declining three straight weeks, increased by 1.7 cents to 114.6 cents. Prices rose by 3.2 cents in Toronto (to a 29-month high), 2.7 cents in Quebec City, 2.3 cents in Montreal, and 1.1 cents in Vancouver and Charlottetown (both to a 28-month high). Prices fell by less than a cent in Winnipeg, St. John's, Saint John, Calgary (to a two-month low), and Edmonton. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the eleventh straight week, by 0.6 cents to 118.6 cents, its highest level since October 2008.

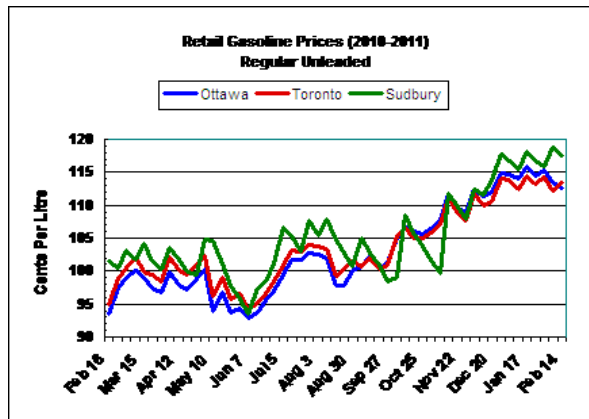
