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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 13, 2011.

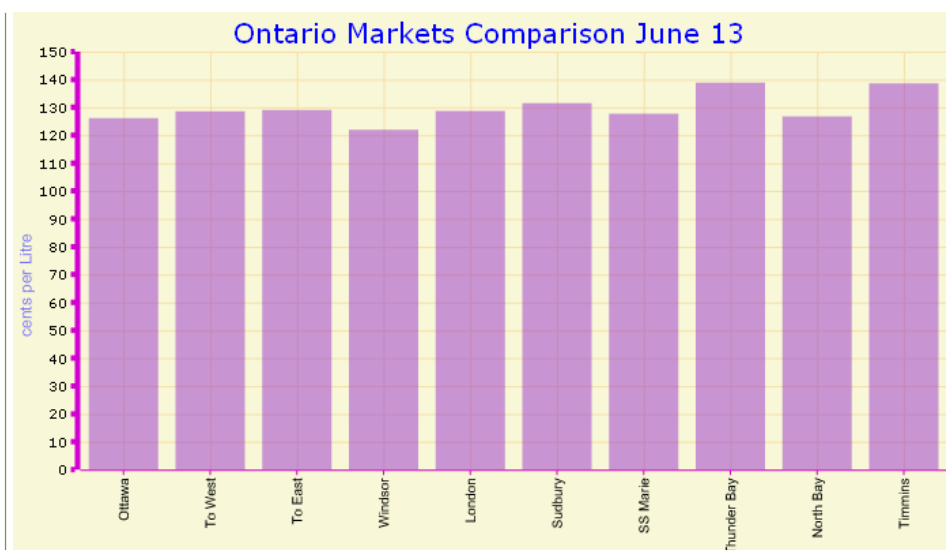
Despite higher North American wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 1.0 cents to 128.5 cents a litre.

Prices fell by 5.9 cents in North Bay, 2.5 cents in Windsor (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low), 1.3 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month low), 1.2 cents in Sudbury and Timmins (both to a two-month low), 1.1 cents in Toronto, and 0.9 cents in London. Prices rose by 0.1 cents in Ottawa. Windsor had the lowest average price for the second straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from 6.4 cents to 5.2 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.2 cents to 124.5 cents, a four-week high.

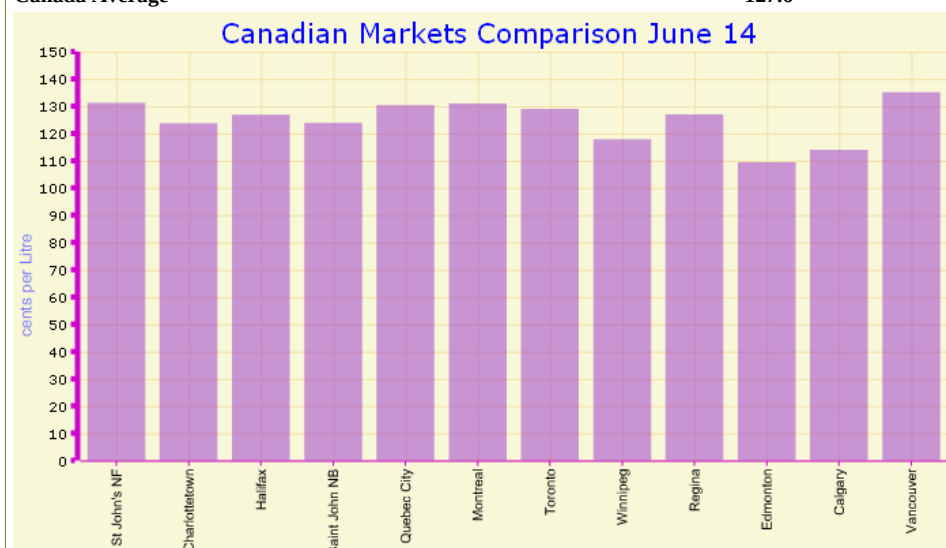
The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the second straight week, by 0.3 cents to 127.3 cents. Prices fell by 3.0 cents in Calgary and Winnipeg (both to a two-month low), 2.1 cents in Edmonton (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in Saint John, 1.2 cents in Quebec City, 1.0 cents in St. John's, and less than a cent in Regina (to a two-month low), Halifax, and Montreal. Prices rose by 1.7 cents in Vancouver (from a three-month low) and 0.4 cents in Toronto. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.2 cents to 124.7 cents, a four-week high.

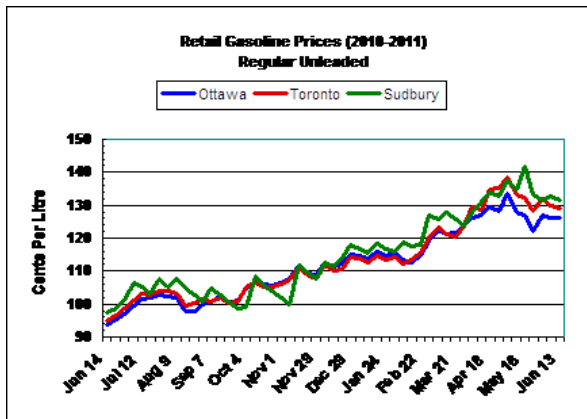
