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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending June 20, 2011.

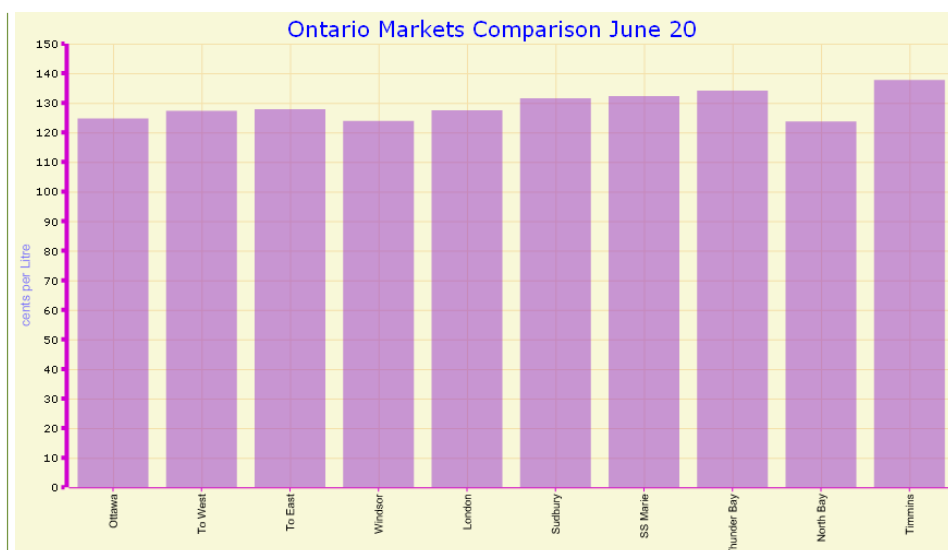
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined for the third straight week, by 1.2 cents to 127.3 cents a litre, a three-month low, despite a slight increase in domestic wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 4.7 cents in Thunder Bay (to a two-month low), 3.0 cents in North Bay (to a three-month low), 1.4 cents in Ottawa, 1.3 cents in Toronto (to a three-month low), 1.2 cents in London (to a three-month low), and 0.9 cents in Timmins (to a two-month low). Prices rose by 4.6 cents in Sault Ste. Marie and 1.9 cents in Windsor (both from a two-month low). The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario shrank slightly to 5.1 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.5 cents to 125.0 cents, a five-week high.

The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined for the third straight week, by 0.7 cents to 126.6 cents, a three-month low. Prices fell by 2.9 cents in Charlottetown (to a three-month low), 1.9 cents in Toronto (to a three-month low), 1.3 cents in Winnipeg (to a three-month low), 1.0 cents in Regina (to a two-month low) and less than a cent in Quebec City, Edmonton (to a three-month low), and Calgary (to a three-month low). Prices rose by less than a cent in Montreal, Saint John, St. John's, and Vancouver. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.6 cents to 125.3 cents, a six-week high.

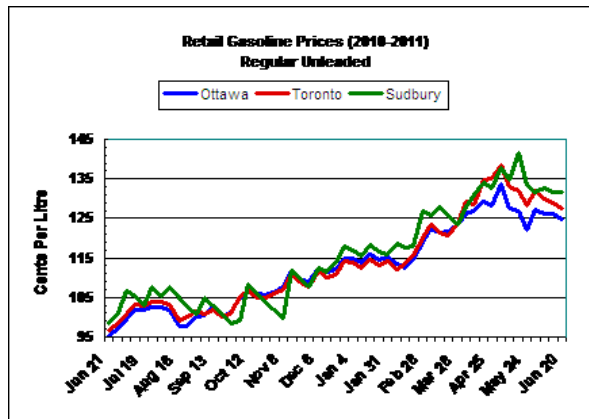
