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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending July 25, 2011.

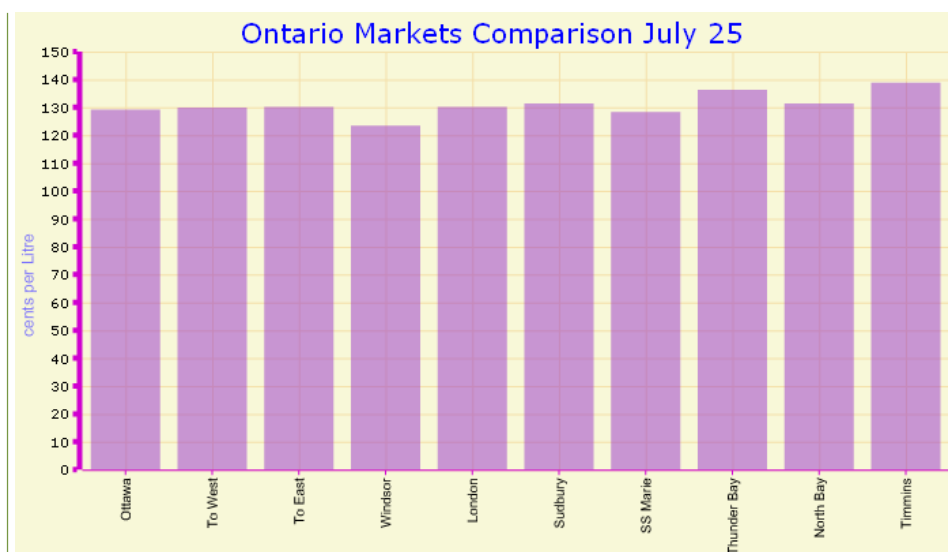
After increasing three straight weeks, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.7 cents from a two-month high to 129.9 cents a litre, reflecting lower domestic wholesale prices.

Prices fell by 5.7 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a two-month high), 3.0 cents in North Bay, 2.7 cents in Sudbury, 2.2 cents in Windsor (from a two-month high), and less than a cent in London (from a two-month high), Toronto (from a two-month high), and Ottawa (from a three-month high). Prices increased by 8.6 cents in Thunder Bay and 0.1 cents in Timmins. Windsor had the lowest average price for the fifth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 2.3 cents to 3.5 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.5 cents to 124.2 cents, a five-week high.

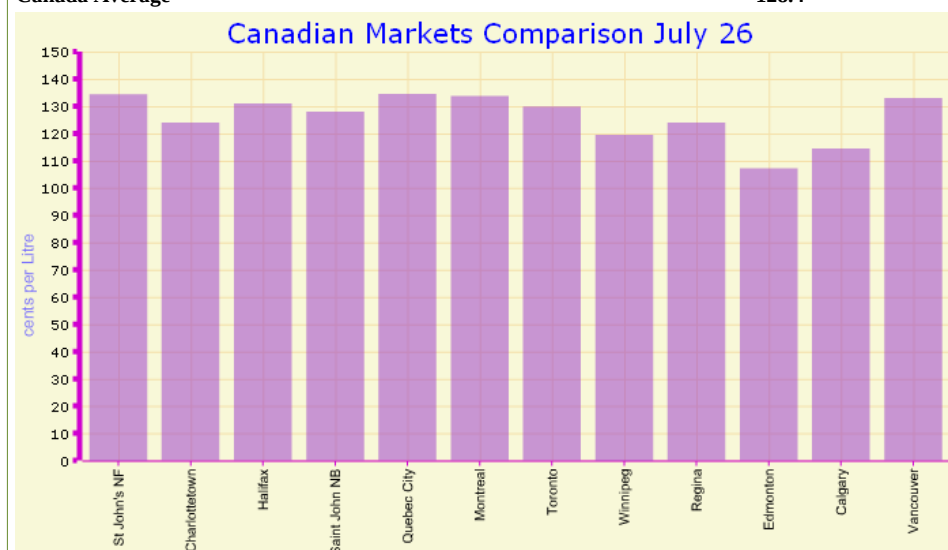
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.3 cents from a two-month high to 128.1 cents. Prices fell by 2.4 cents in Edmonton, 1.2 cents in Quebec City (from a two-month high), and less than a cent in Montreal, Toronto (from a two-month high), Vancouver, and Calgary. Prices rose by 6.8 cents in Winnipeg (to a two-month high), 1.3 cents in St. John's (to a two-month high), and 0.7 cents in Saint John (to a three-month high). The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the third straight week, by 0.8 cents to 124.3 cents, a five-week high.

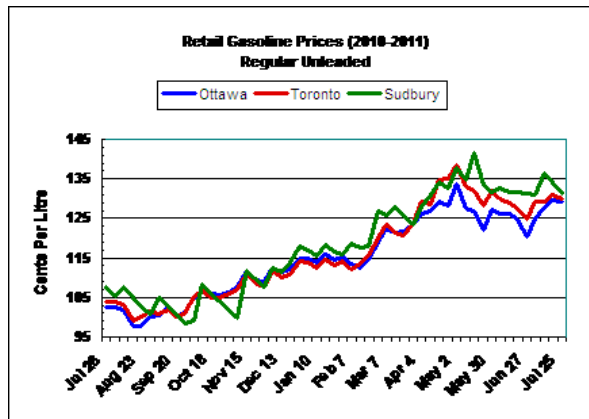
