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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 2, 2011.

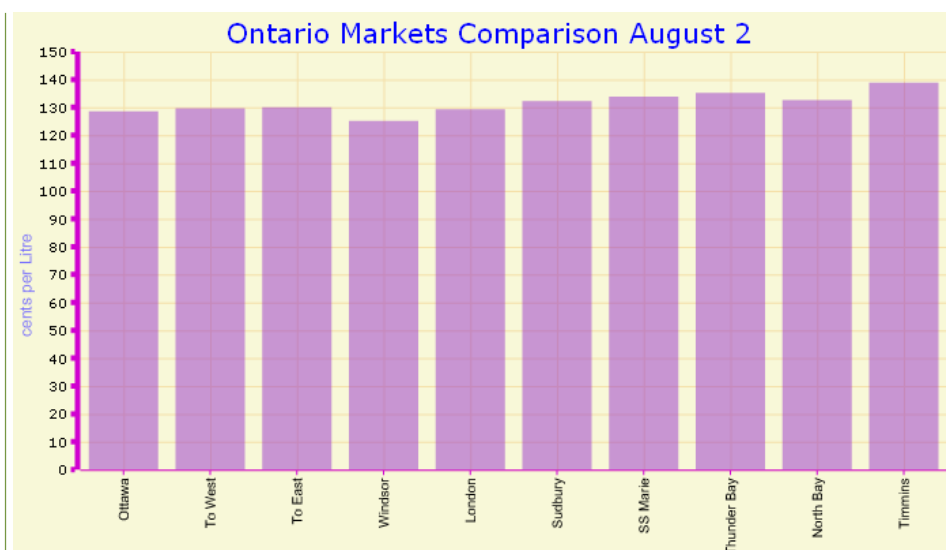
Despite higher domestic wholesale prices, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.1 cents to 129.8 cents a litre, a three-week low.

Prices fell by 1.1 cents in Thunder Bay and less than a cent in London, Ottawa, and Toronto. Prices rose by 5.5 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 1.7 cents in Windsor, 1.2 cents in North Bay, and 0.8 cents in Sudbury. Windsor had the lowest average price for the sixth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened from 3.5 cents to 4.8 cents, a five-week high. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.4 cents to 123.8 cents.

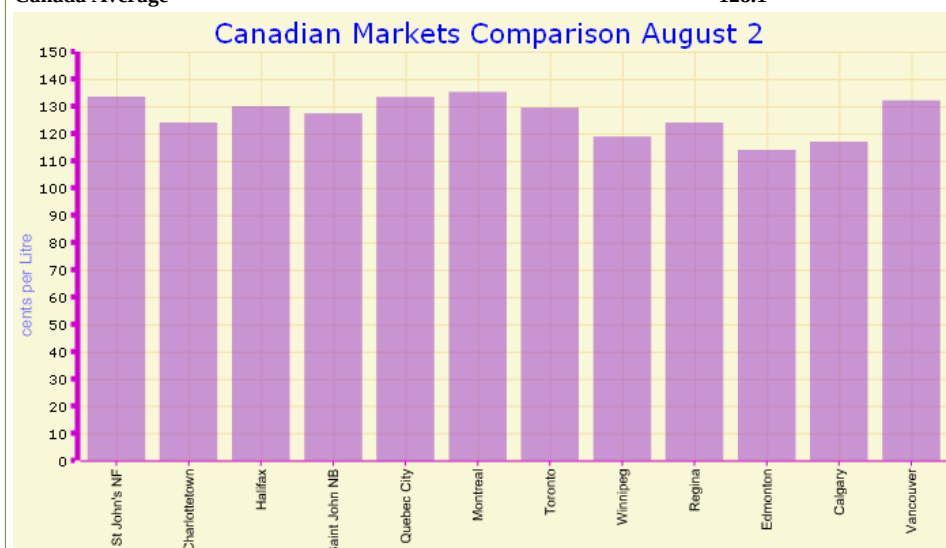
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.3 cents to 128.4 cents. Prices rose by 6.7 cents in Edmonton (to a two-month high), 2.5 cents in Calgary (to a two-month high), and 1.5 cents in Montreal (to a three-month high). Prices fell by 1.1 cents in Quebec City, 1.0 cents in Halifax, and less than a cent in St. John's (from a two-month high), Vancouver, Winnipeg (from a two-month high), Saint John (from a three-month high), and Toronto. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after increasing three straight weeks, declined by 0.2 cents to 124.1 cents.

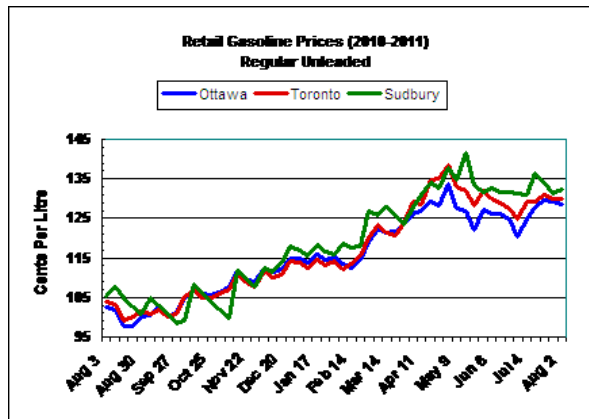
