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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 8, 2011.

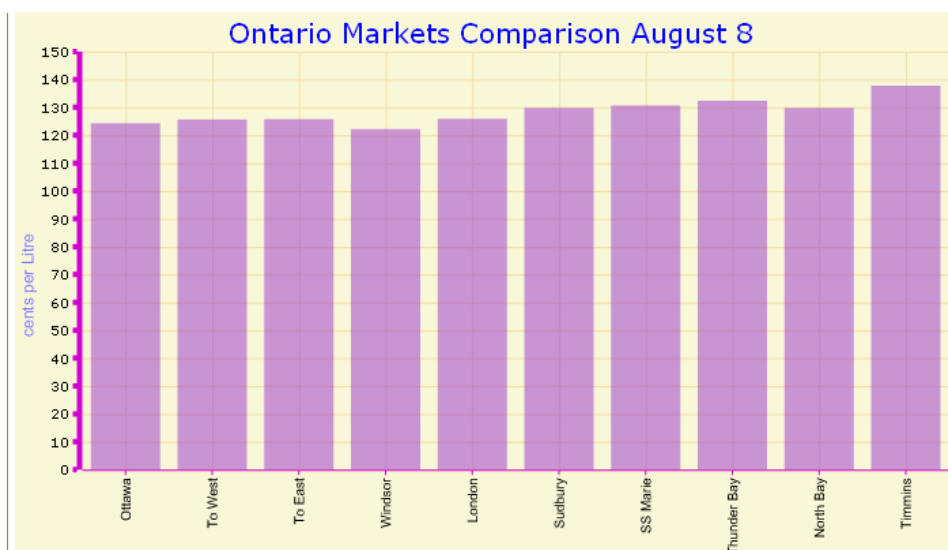
Lower world crude oil and North American wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline for the third straight week, by 3.9 cents to 125.9 cents a litre, a six-week low.

Prices fell by 4.2 cents in both Ottawa and Toronto, 3.4 cents in London, 3.2 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, 2.9 cents in both Windsor and Thunder Bay, 2.8 cents in North Bay, 2.4 cents in Sudbury (to a four-month low), and 1.1 cents in Timmins. Windsor had the lowest average price for the seventh straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened for the third straight week, from 4.8 cents to 6.2 cents, a two-month high. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the second straight week, by 0.6 cents to 123.2 cents, a five-week low.

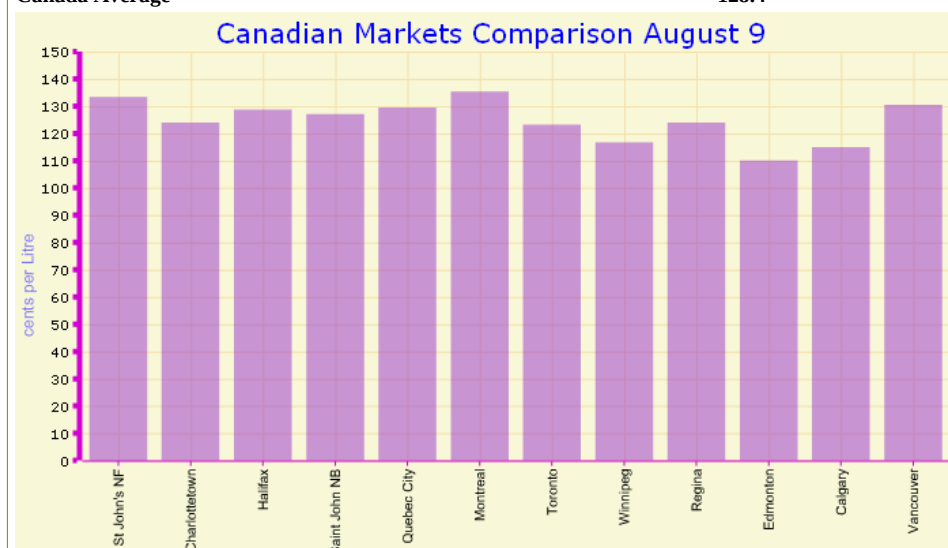
The Canadian retail gasoline price fell by 2.9 cents to 125.5 cents, a six-week low. Prices fell by 6.3 cents in Toronto (to a four-month low), 4.0 cents in Quebec City, 3.2 cents in Edmonton (from a two-month high), 2.1 cents in Winnipeg, 2.0 cents in Calgary (from a two-month high), 1.6 cents in Vancouver (to a five-month low), 1.3 cents in Halifax, and less than a cent in Saint John and St. John's. Prices rose by 0.1 cents in Montreal (from a three-month low). The Canadian retail diesel price fell for the second straight week, by 1.3 cents to 122.8 cents, a four-week low.

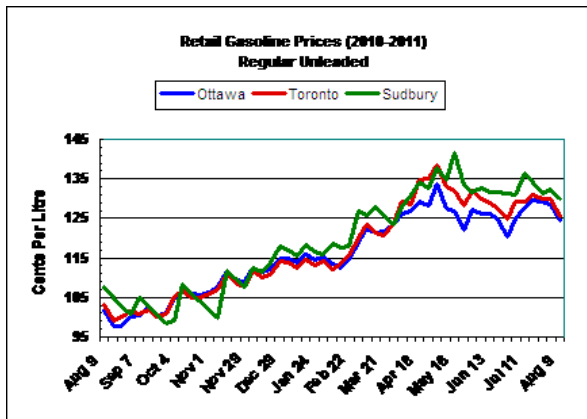
