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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 15, 2011.

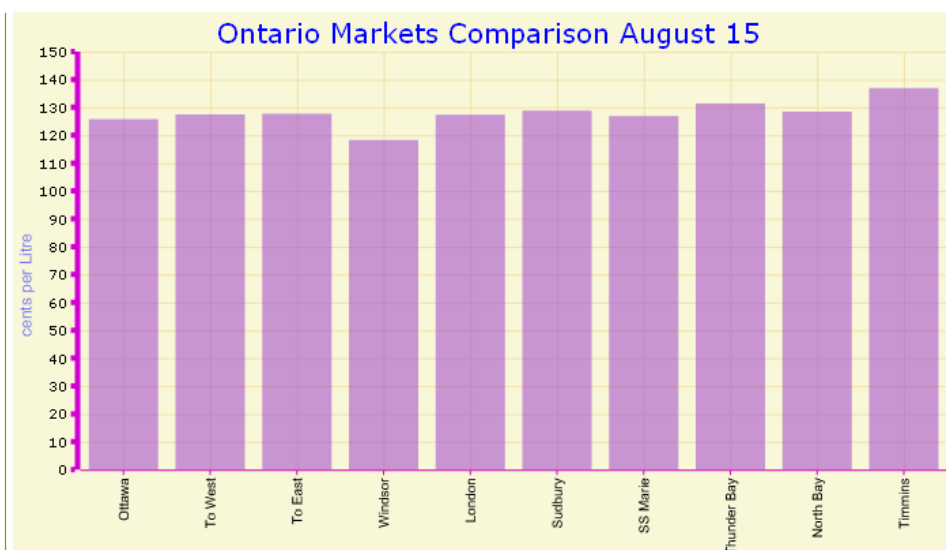
After declining three straight weeks, the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased by 1.1 cents from a six-week low to 127.0 cents a litre, reflecting higher North American wholesale prices.

Prices rose by 1.9 cents in Toronto, 1.5 cents in Ottawa, and 1.4 cents in London. Prices fell by 3.9 cents in Windsor (to a four-month low), 3.8 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a four-month low), 1.4 cents in North Bay (to a two-month low), 1.0 cents in Sudbury (to a four-month low), and 0.9 cents in both Thunder Bay and Timmins. Windsor had the lowest average price for the eighth straight week. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the third straight week, by 0.5 cents to 122.7 cents, a six-week low.

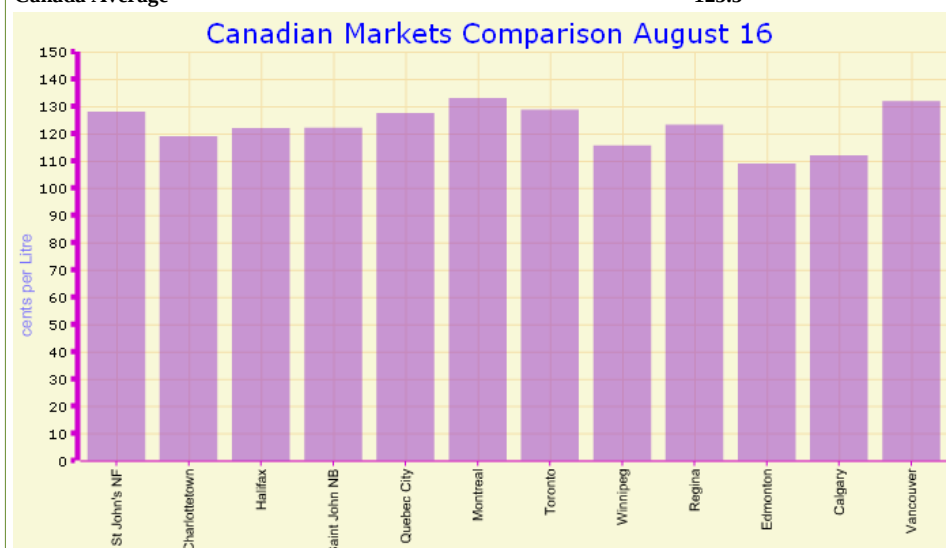
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 0.9 cents from a six-week low to 126.4 cents. Prices rose by 5.5 cents in Toronto (from a four-month low) and 1.3 cents in Vancouver (from a five-month low). Prices fell by 6.7 cents in Halifax (to a seven-month low), 5.5 cents in St. John's, 5.0 cents in both Saint John and Charlottetown, 3.0 cents in Calgary (to a two-month low), 2.3 cents in Montreal (from a three-month high), 2.0 cents in Quebec City, 1.2 cents in Winnipeg, and less than a cent in Edmonton and Regina (the latter to a five-month low). The Canadian average retail diesel price fell for the third straight week, by 1.1 cents to 121.7 cents, a six-week low.

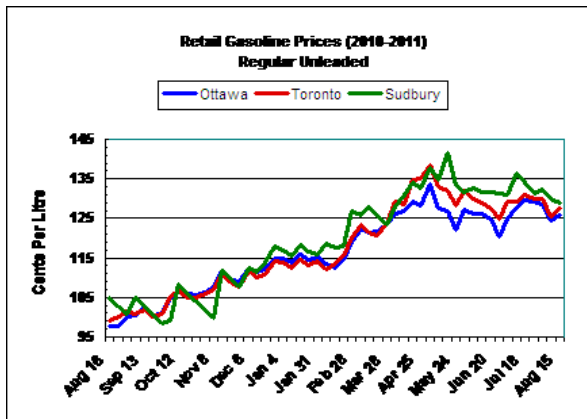
