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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 22, 2011.

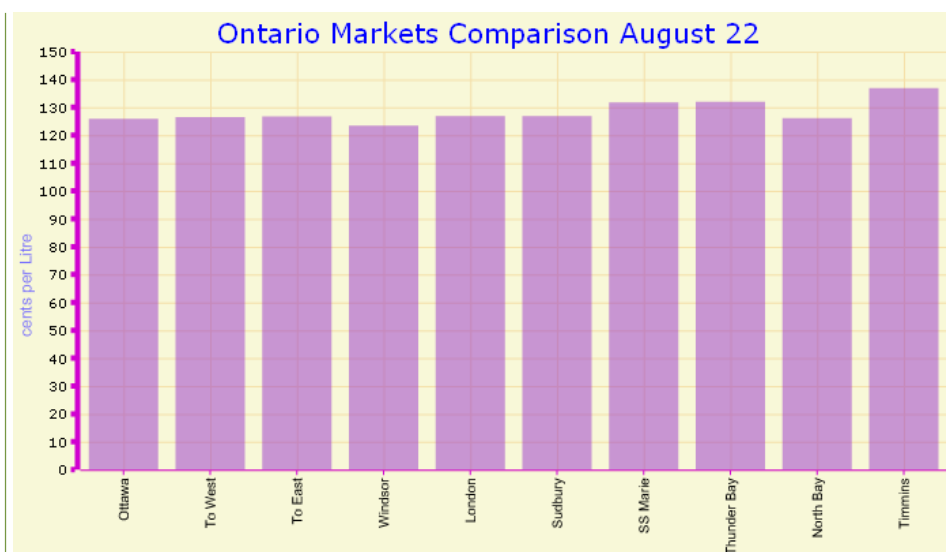
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline declined by 0.3 cents to 126.7 cents a litre, as sizeable price jumps in Windsor and Sault Ste. Marie were outweighed by decreases elsewhere.

Prices fell by 2.3 cents in North Bay (to a two-month low), 2.0 cents in Sudbury (to a five-month low), 1.0 cents in Toronto, and 0.5 cents in London. Prices rose by 5.1 cents in Windsor (from a four-month low), 5.0 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (from a four-month low), and less than a cent in Thunder Bay and Ottawa. Windsor had the lowest average price for the ninth straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened slightly to 3.6 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fourth straight week, by 0.4 cents to 122.3 cents, a six-month low.

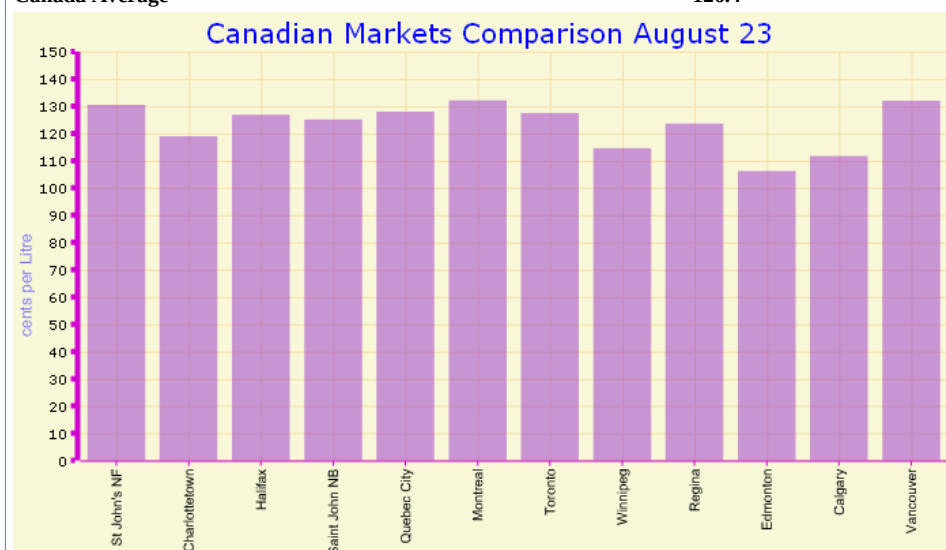
The Canadian average retail gasoline price declined by 0.4 cents to 126.0 cents. Prices fell by 2.5 cents in Edmonton (to a two-month low), 1.2 cents in Toronto, and less than a cent in Montreal (to a two-month low), Winnipeg, and Calgary (to a five-month low). Prices rose by 4.8 cents in Halifax (from a seven-month low), 3.0 cents in Saint John, 2.6 cents in St. John's, and less than a cent in Quebec City, Regina (from a five-month low), and Vancouver. The Canadian average retail diesel price, after declining three straight weeks, increased by 0.2 cents from a six-week low to 121.9 cents.

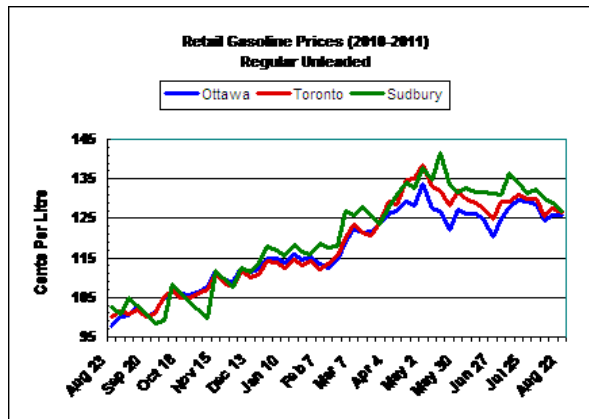
