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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending August 29, 2011.

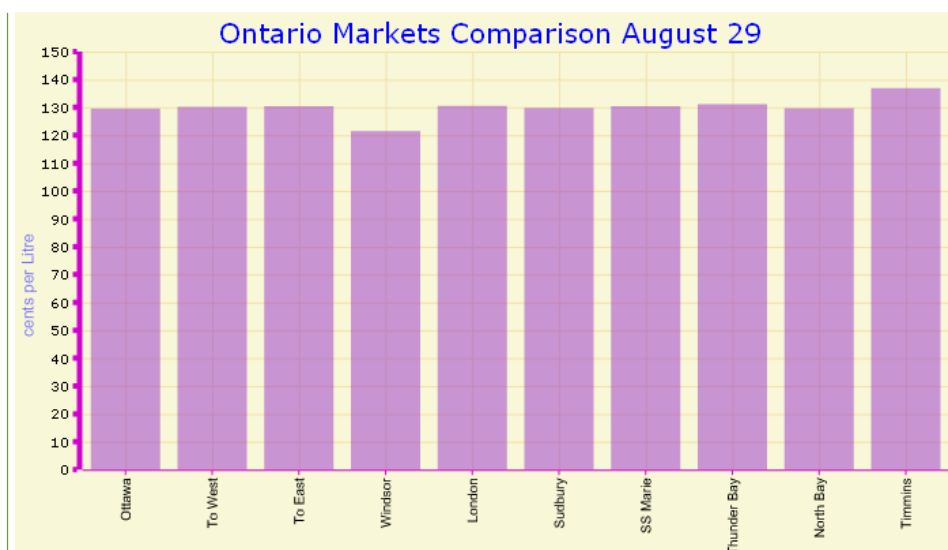
Higher world crude oil and North American wholesale prices caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to increase by 3.1 cents to 129.8 cents a litre, a four-week high.

Prices rose by 3.7 cents in London and Toronto, 3.6 cents in Ottawa and North Bay (the latter from a two-month low), and 3.0 cents in Sudbury (from a five-month low). Prices fell by 1.9 cents in Windsor, 1.4 cents in Sault Ste. Marie, and 0.9 cents in Thunder Bay. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario narrowed from 3.6 cents to 1.3 cents, a two-month low. The Ontario average retail diesel price declined for the fifth straight week, by 0.2 cents to 122.1 cents, a six-month low.

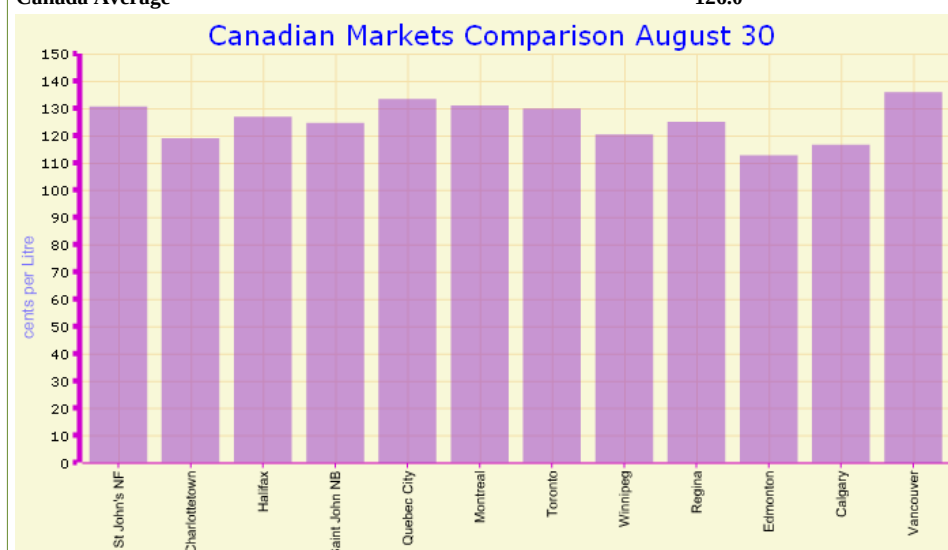
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased by 2.0 cents to 128.0 cents, a four-week high. Prices rose by 6.5 cents in Edmonton (from a two-month low), 5.7 cents in Winnipeg (to a three-month high), 5.4 cents in Quebec City, 4.8 cents in Calgary (from a five-month low), 4.0 cents in Vancouver (to a three-month high), 2.3 cents in Toronto, 1.3 cents in Regina (to a two-month high), and 0.1 cents in St. John's. Prices fell by 1.2 cents in Montreal (to a two-month low) and 0.5 cents in Saint John. The Canadian average retail diesel price declined by 0.2 cents to 121.7 cents.

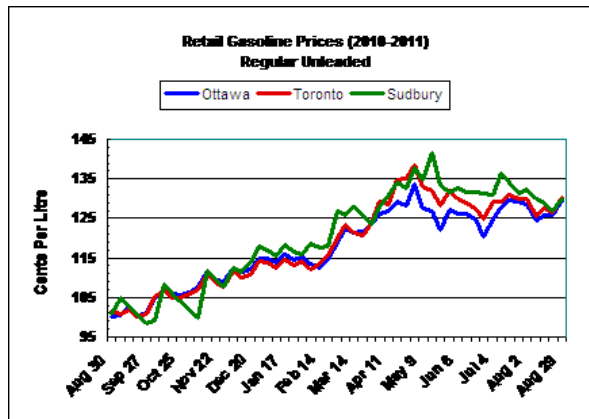
