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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 6, 2011.

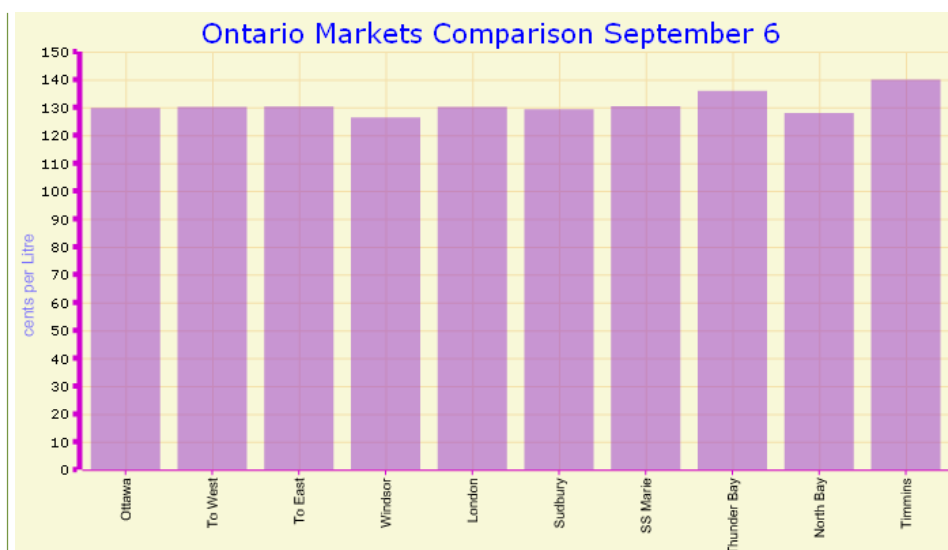
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased for the second straight week, by 0.3 cents to 130.1 cents a litre, a two-month high, reflecting a modest increase in domestic wholesale prices.

Prices rose by 4.8 cents in Windsor (to a three-month high) and Thunder Bay, 3.0 cents in Timmins (to a three-month high), and 0.3 cents in Ottawa (to a four-month high). Prices fell by 1.7 cents in North Bay and less than a cent in Sudbury, London, and Toronto East. Despite its increase, Windsor remained the lowest-priced market for the 11th straight week. The average price gap between northern and southern Ontario widened to 2.3 cents from a two-month low of 1.3 cents. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining five straight weeks to a six-month low, increased by 1.3 cents to 123.4 cents.

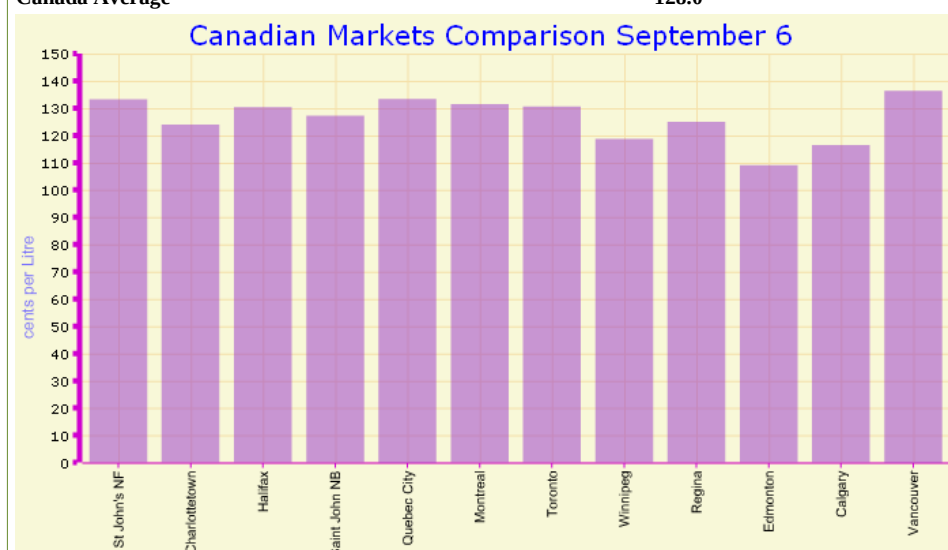
The Canadian average retail gasoline price increased for the second straight week, by 0.6 cents to 128.6 cents, a three-month high. Prices rose by 5.0 cents in Charlottetown, 3.5 cents in Halifax, 2.6 cents in Saint John and St. John's, and less than a cent in Toronto (to a three-month high), Montreal (from a two-month low), and Vancouver (to a three-month high). Prices fell by 3.6 cents in Edmonton, 1.6 cents in Winnipeg (from a three-month high), and 0.1 cents in Calgary. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased by 2.1 cents to 123.8 cents, a five-week high.

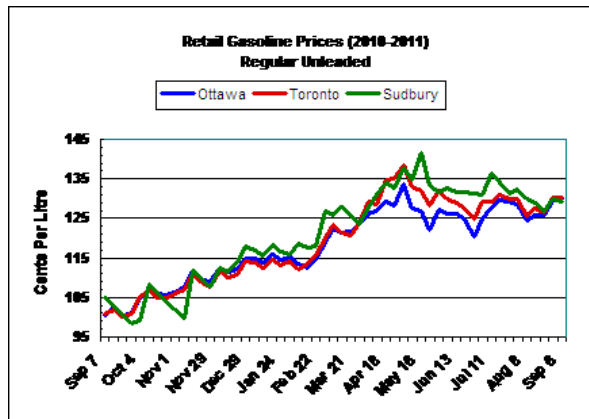
