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GASOLINE REPORT

Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending September 12, 2011.

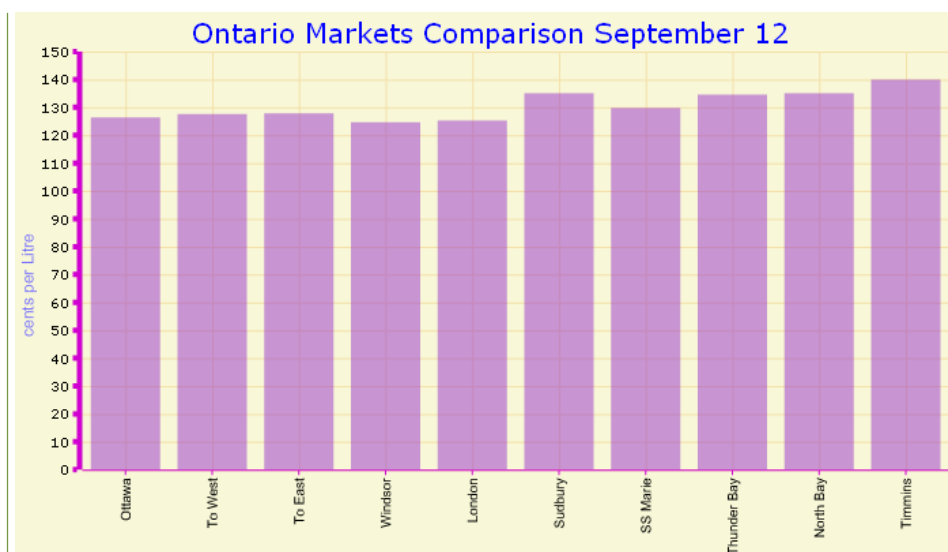
Lower North American wholesale prices and some local price war activity caused the Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline to decline by 2.2 cents from a two-month high to 127.9 cents a litre.

Prices fell by 4.9 cents in London (to a three-month low), 3.4 cents in Ottawa (from a four-month high), 2.5 cents in Toronto, 1.7 cents in Windsor (from a three-month high), 1.3 cents in Thunder Bay, and 0.6 cents in Sault Ste. Marie. Prices rose by 7.1 cents in North Bay and 5.7 cents in Sudbury (both to a two-month high). The Ontario average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 1.2 cents to 124.6 cents, a three-month high.

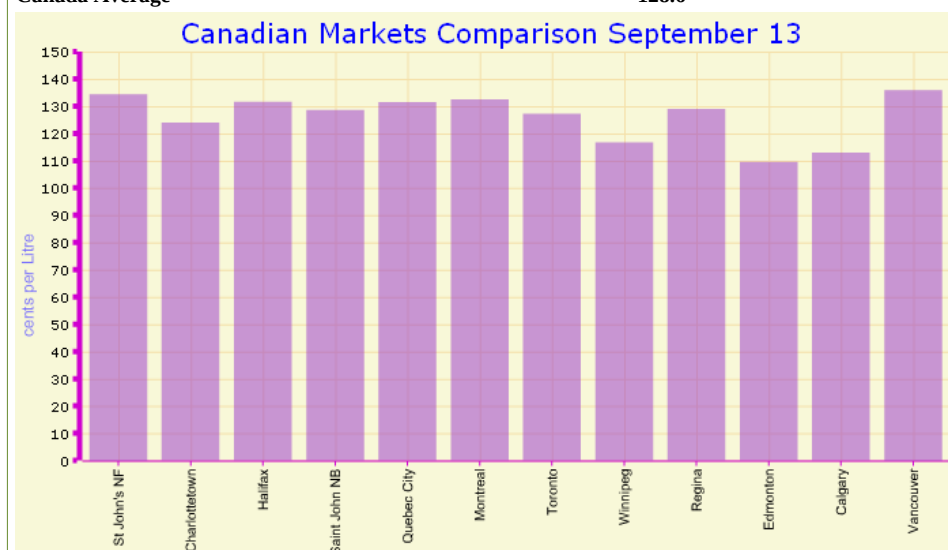
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after increasing two straight weeks, declined by 1.4 cents from a three-month high to 127.2 cents. Prices fell by 3.5 cents in Calgary, 3.4 cents in Toronto (from a three-month high), 2.0 cents in Winnipeg and Quebec City, and 0.5 cents in Vancouver (from a three-month high). Prices rose by 4.0 cents in Regina (to a four-month high), 1.4 cents in Saint John (to a four-month high), 1.3 cents in Halifax (to a four-month high), 1.2 cents in St. John's (to a two-month high), 1.0 cents in Montreal, and 0.4 cents in Edmonton. The Canadian average retail diesel price increased for the second straight week, by 0.7 cents to 124.5 cents, a three-month high.

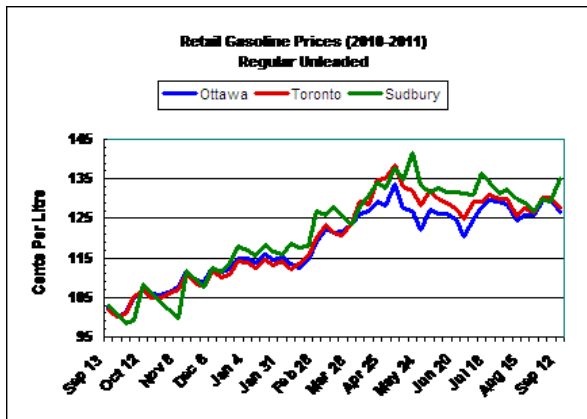
