Gasoline Report

The Gasoline Report is a roundup of consumer gasoline prices from across Ontario and Canada. The graph shows price trends for three Ontario cities for the previous 12 month period. The report and graph are updated weekly. This week's Gasoline Report is for the week ending October 11, 2011.

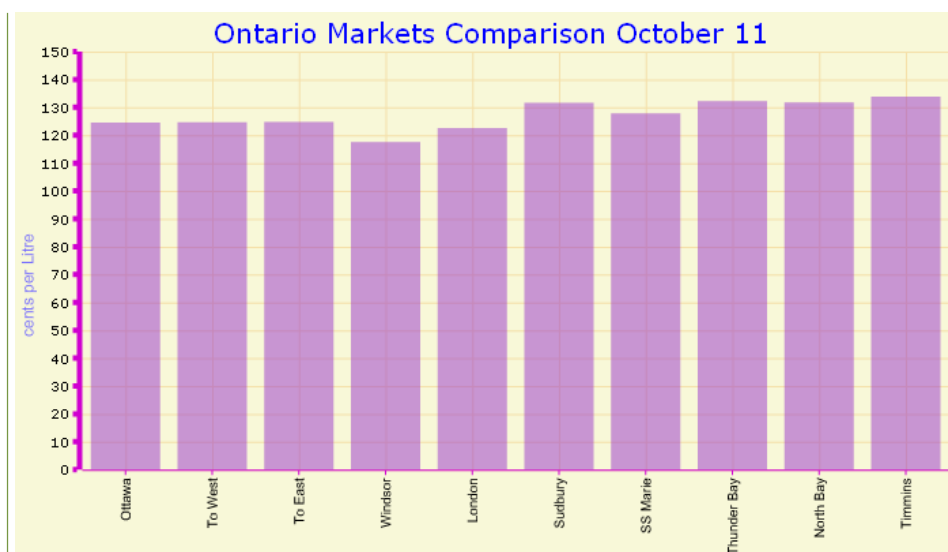
The Ontario average retail price of regular unleaded gasoline increased for the second straight week, by 2.3 cents to 124.9 cents a litre, reflecting higher world crude oil and North American wholesale prices.

Prices rose by 9.1 cents in Sudbury (from a seven-month low), 8.9 cents in North Bay (from a seven-month low), 2.5 cents in Ottawa, 2.4 cents in Toronto, and 2.2 cents in London. Prices fell by 3.0 cents in Windsor (to a seven-month low), 2.1 cents in Timmins (to a six-month low), 1.3 cents in Sault Ste. Marie (to a two-month low), and 0.4 cents in Thunder Bay. The Ontario average retail diesel price, after declining three straight weeks, increased by 0.8 cents to 123.3 cents.

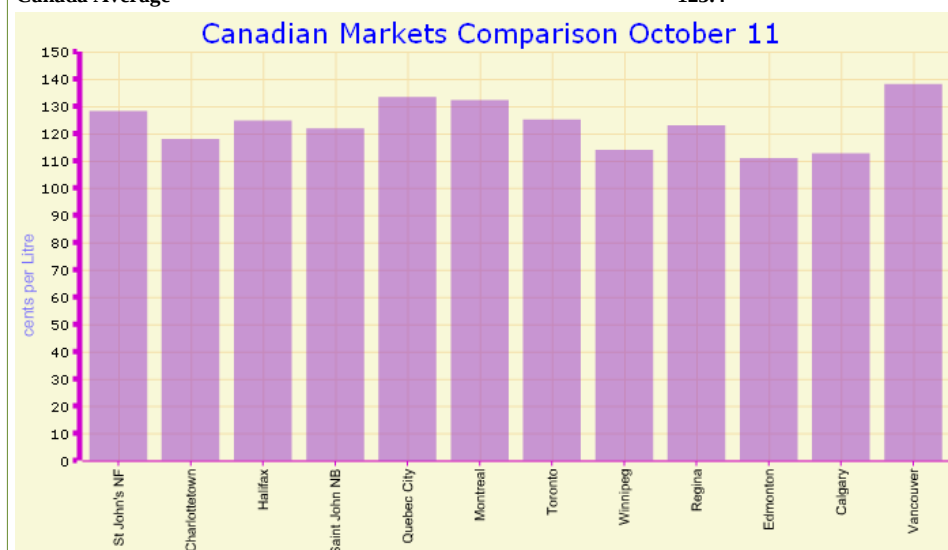
The Canadian average retail gasoline price, after declining four straight weeks, increased by 2.2 cents from a six-month low to 125.6 cents. Prices rose by 6.6 cents in Edmonton, 6.0 cents in Quebec City (from a two-month low), 4.8 cents in Calgary, 3.4 cents in Toronto (from a six-month low), 2.2 cents in Halifax (from a two-month low), 1.4 cents in Vancouver (to a five-month high), and less than a cent in St. John's (from a three-month low), Saint John (from a three-month low), and Montreal. Prices fell by 2.5 cents in Winnipeg. The Canadian average retail diesel price rose by 1.6 cents to 124.3 cents, a four-week high.

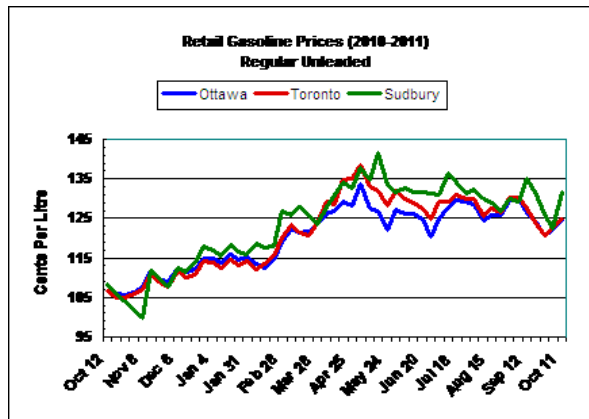
