

List of Management Units and Forest Management Plan Renewal Schedule

(January 2012)

For the purposes of forest management, Ontario's Crown forest is divided into geographic planning areas known as management units. Forest management plans are prepared for each of these management units and are periodically renewed based on the forest management planning cycle.

This list of management units is organized by the scheduled plan renewal year (i.e. scheduled year of implementation) and includes the applicable lead MNR District and MNR Region. New plans are normally scheduled to be implemented in April of the applicable plan renewal year. For those units initiating planning in the coming year, a notice requesting public involvement will normally be issued between January and March of 2012.

To assist in the delivery of new forest management business directions and to realize efficiencies in forest management planning, the Ministry of Natural Resources is reducing the total number of individual management units through management unit amalgamation. Anticipated amalgamations are noted. Management Unit names/numbers will change as these amalgamations occur.

A small-scale map showing the general location of each management unit and a list of current Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources Districts are included. For information on a specific management unit or forest management plan, please contact the District Manager at the Ministry of Natural Resources District indicated in the list.

This list is prepared annually as required by Condition #1. (d) of the Class Environmental Assessment Approval for Forest Management on Crown Lands in Ontario (dated June 25, 2003).

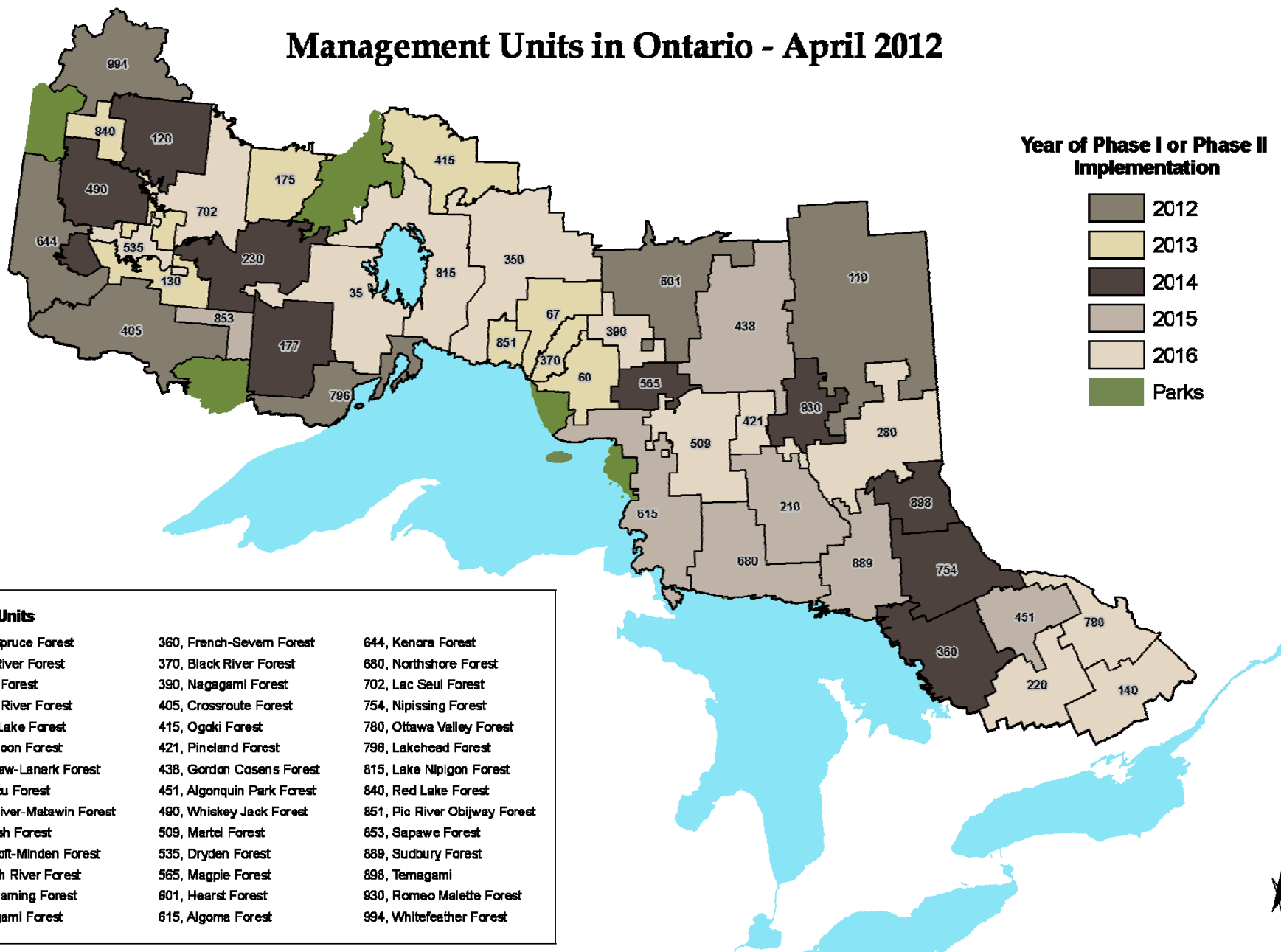
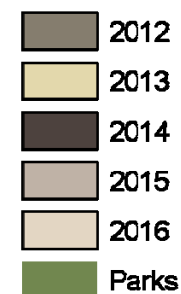

The first year that the second phase (Phase II) of the 2007 plans will occur is 2012.

Starting in 2010, plans prepared under the 1996FMPM became eligible to have their period extended by 1 or 2 years. This is referred to as a “**Plan Extension**”

1. Abitibi River Forest completed a 2-year contingency plan (2010-2012) with a new plan being implemented in 2012.
2. The Big Pic Forest was scheduled to implement Phase II in 2012 but has been delayed to 2013.
3. The Pic River Ojibway Forest will have the current plan (2006-2011) extended for a 2nd year (2012-2013). The Black River Forest will prepare a 1 year contingency plan for 2012-2013. The Black and Pic River Ojibway Forests will amalgamate into the new
4. The Dog River-Matawin Forest initiated plan renewal 1 year early (2009).
5. The first 2 years of the Gordon Cosens Forest 2010-2020 FMP was a contingency plan. The plan was finalized for implementation in 2012.
6. The Kenogami Forest prepared a 1 year contingency plan for 2011-12. The contingency plan will also be the first year of the new plan that will be approved for April 2012.
7. The Whiskey Jack Crown unit had a 3 year contingency plan (2009-2012) and is implementing another 2-year contingency plan for 2012-2014 bridging to a new plan (2014-2024).
8. The Whitefeather Forest Declaration Order (MNR-74) was approved in April 18, 2009 and was designated as a management unit in 2010. Its first Forest Management Plan is scheduled to be implemented in 2012. The SFL will be issued prior to implementation
