Overview

Keeping Northern Ontario Strong – Today and in the Future

The provincial highways system is critical to Ontario's economy and quality of life. In Northern Ontario, where vast distances separate communities and key market areas, the almost 11,000 kilometres of highway are true economic lifelines.

The Ontario government's Northern Prosperity Plan envisions a future of growth and prosperity for all northerners. To help achieve this, the government is strengthening the North's economic advantage by significantly investing in its infrastructure.

This year, through the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines' Northern Highways Program, the government will invest a record \$357 million in highway rehabilitation, expansion and safety improvements.

The Ministry of Northern Development and Mines (NDM) establishes and manages the budget for the annual highways' program and works jointly with the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) to identify program priorities based on advice and recommendations from MTO. MTO is responsible for delivering the construction program and maintaining the highway system.

This report details the specific projects that will be undertaken in 2006 including 36 new projects and 16 projects carried forward from previous years. It also includes projects up to 2010, the end of this five-year investment in highway construction. It will be published annually to provide a clear

understanding of where and how tax dollars are being spent. It is also one more way that the government is delivering on its promise to Ontarians to be accountable and transparent in the way it conducts business.

Last year, we released the Northern Ontario Highways Strategy, setting out the first ever five-year, \$1.8-billion program for all northern highways. The Northern Ontario Highways Strategy provided northerners with a comprehensive, multi-year picture of highway investments. It set real targets and priorities and identified necessary resources. The strategy also included plans to complete the four-laning of Highways 11 and 69 in 7 and 12 years respectively.

The strategy was part of the government's broader infrastructure plan called *ReNew Ontario* – a \$30-billion plan to strengthen Ontario's economy and communities. The government's commitment to building and renewing infrastructure was reaffirmed in the 2006 Ontario Budget, which announced the *Move Ontario* initiative. Through *Move Ontario*, northern municipalities received \$56.5 million in immediate, one-time funding for road, bridge repair and upgrading.

The Ontario government believes that by investing in transportation infrastructure, we are making roads safer, spurring economic growth, creating jobs and keeping people and goods moving. We will continue to do our part, and to pursue every opportunity to discuss new funding partnerships with the federal government. By working with northerners, we will create a highway system capable of supporting economic growth and prosperity across Northern Ontario for decades to come.

Part I: Accomplishments 2005

In 2005, the Ontario Government invested \$296 million to expand and repair highway infrastructure in Northern Ontario.

The highway construction program for 2005 included 27 new projects and 30 projects carried forward from previous years. Of these, 41 projects were completed, including:

Two to four-lane widening of Highway 11 from Emsdale to Katrine: Widening the highway improves road safety and prepare northern communities for future growth.

Rehabilitation of the Baudette/Rainy River International Bridge on Highway 11: Improvements to the bridge enhance road safety and keep drivers moving efficiently to and from Ontario.

Passing lanes on Highway 69 in the Highway 522 vicinity, south of French River: The new passing lanes provide motorists with an improved level of road safety.

Resurfacing on Highway 11 from Kapuskasing east limits easterly: Resurfacing almost 15 km of highway provides motorists with a smoother driving surface.

Resurfacing and truck climbing lanes on Highway 11 from Highway 527 easterly, east of Thunder Bay: Resurfacing the highway will provide motorists with a smoother driving surface while the new truck climbing lanes will enhance road safety.

A complete listing of the major highway construction projects completed in 2005 is provided in the appendix to this document.

A summary of the accomplishments related to the 2005 construction program is outlined below:

- **6 km of additional highway were completed**
- **7 new bridges were built**
- **19 bridges were repaired**
- **383 km of highways were repaired**
- **Operational improvements included shoulder improvements and truck climbing lanes**
- **Over 7,000 jobs were created across Ontario**

2006 Summary

In 2006, the Ontario Government plans to invest \$357 million to expand and repair highway infrastructure in Northern Ontario.

The highway construction program for 2006 will include 36 new projects and 16 projects carried forward from previous years. Some key projects include:

Northeastern Ontario

- Four-laning of Highway 11 from South River to Sundridge. Widening this highway will improve road safety and support economic development. Expected completion: 2010.
- Resurfacing 26.4 km of Highway 17, west of Mattawa, including passing lane extensions and bridge rehabilitations. Improvements to this section of highway will provide motorists with a smoother drive and improved road safety. Expected completion: 2007.
- Resurfacing 28.1 km of Highway 144 from north of Highway 661 to Gogama. Resurfacing this section of highway will provide motorists with a smoother drive. Expected completion: 2006.

Northwestern Ontario

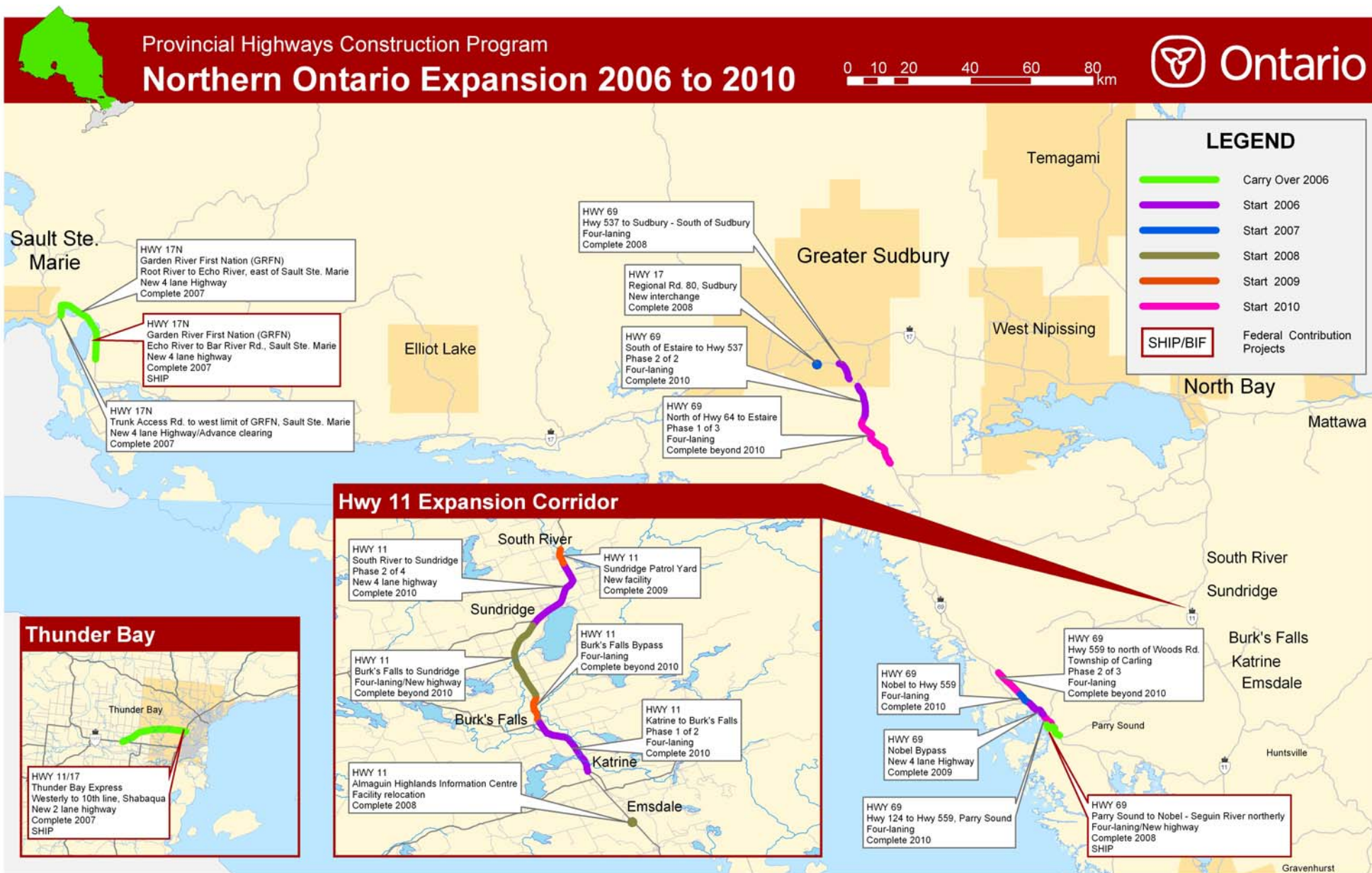
- Reconstructing 12.2 km of Highway 11/17, including truck climbing lanes east of Thunder Bay. These improvements will improve road safety and access for local residents. Expected completion: 2007
- Reconstructing 26.5 km of Highway 584 north of

Geraldton. Improvements to this section of highway will improve road safety and driving conditions. Expected completion: 2006

- Bridge replacement at Sioux Narrows on Highway 71. Replacing this bridge will enhance road safety and keep motorists moving efficiently through Northwestern Ontario. Expected completion: 2007

Planned improvements related to the 2006 construction plan are outlined below:

- **43 bridges will be rehabilitated**
- **420 km of highway will be repaired**
- **Operational improvements will include intersection improvements, passing lanes, highway lighting, rock hazards, truck climbing lanes and rumble strips**
- **Almost 9,000 jobs will be created across Ontario**



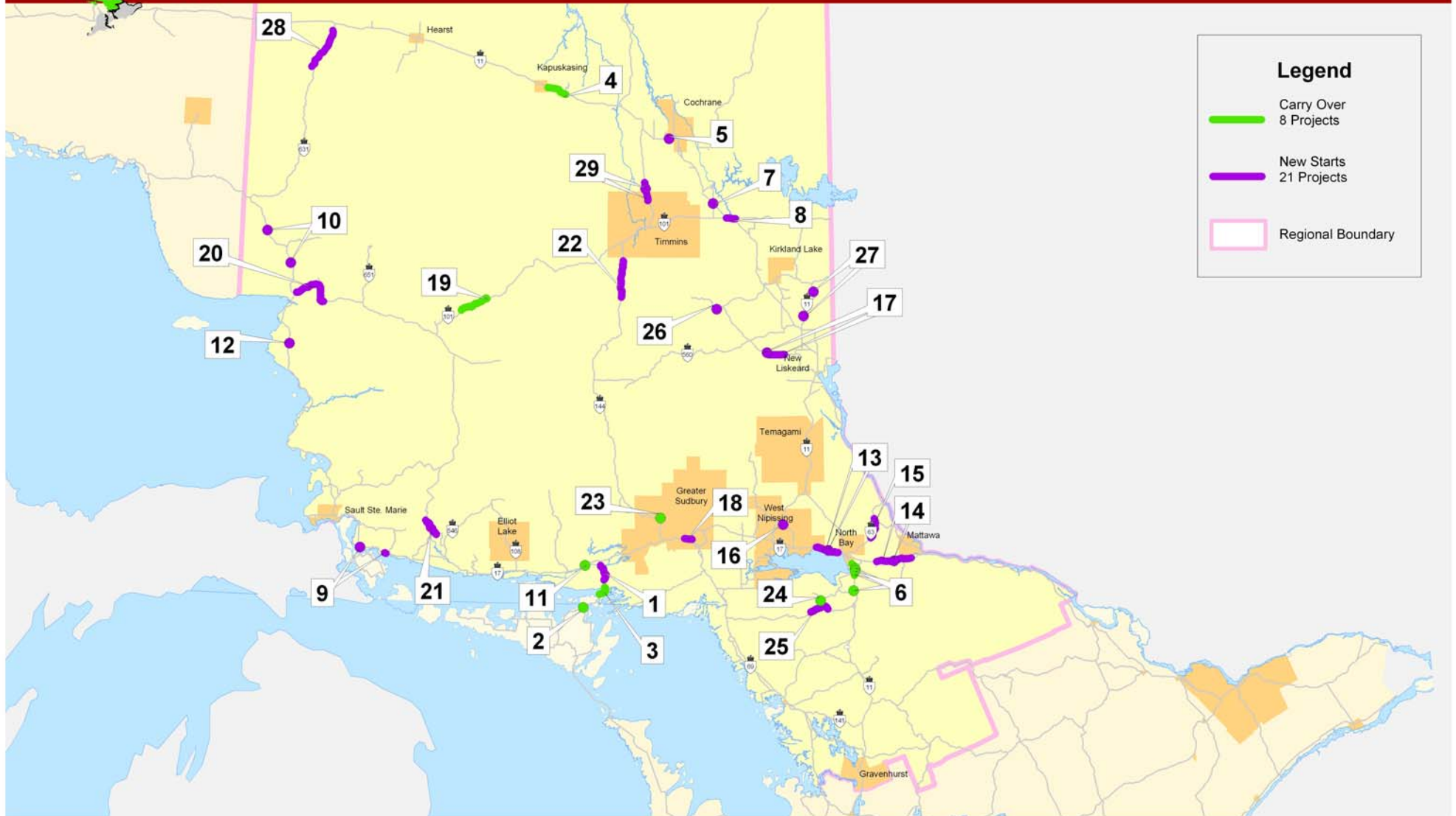

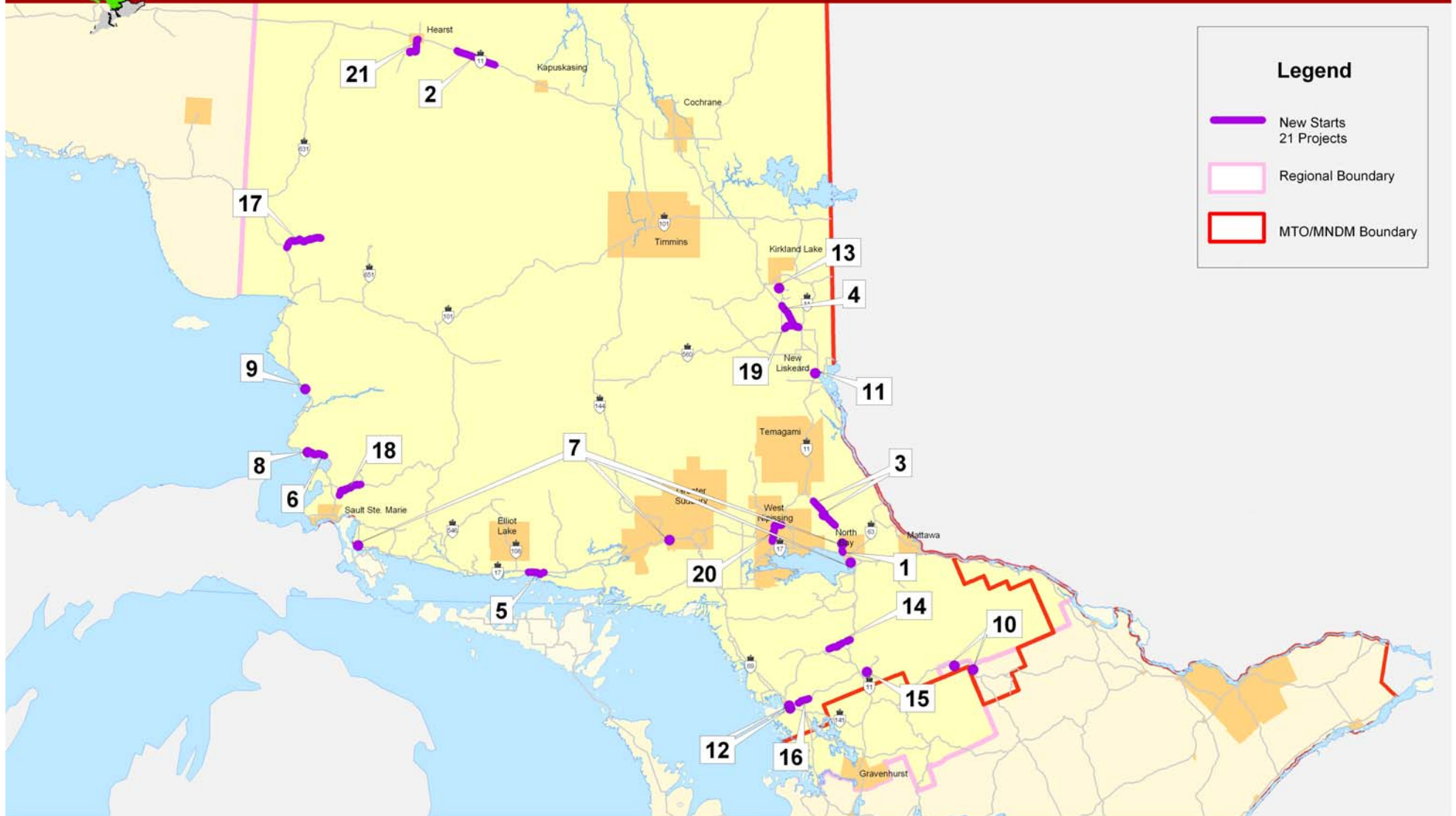

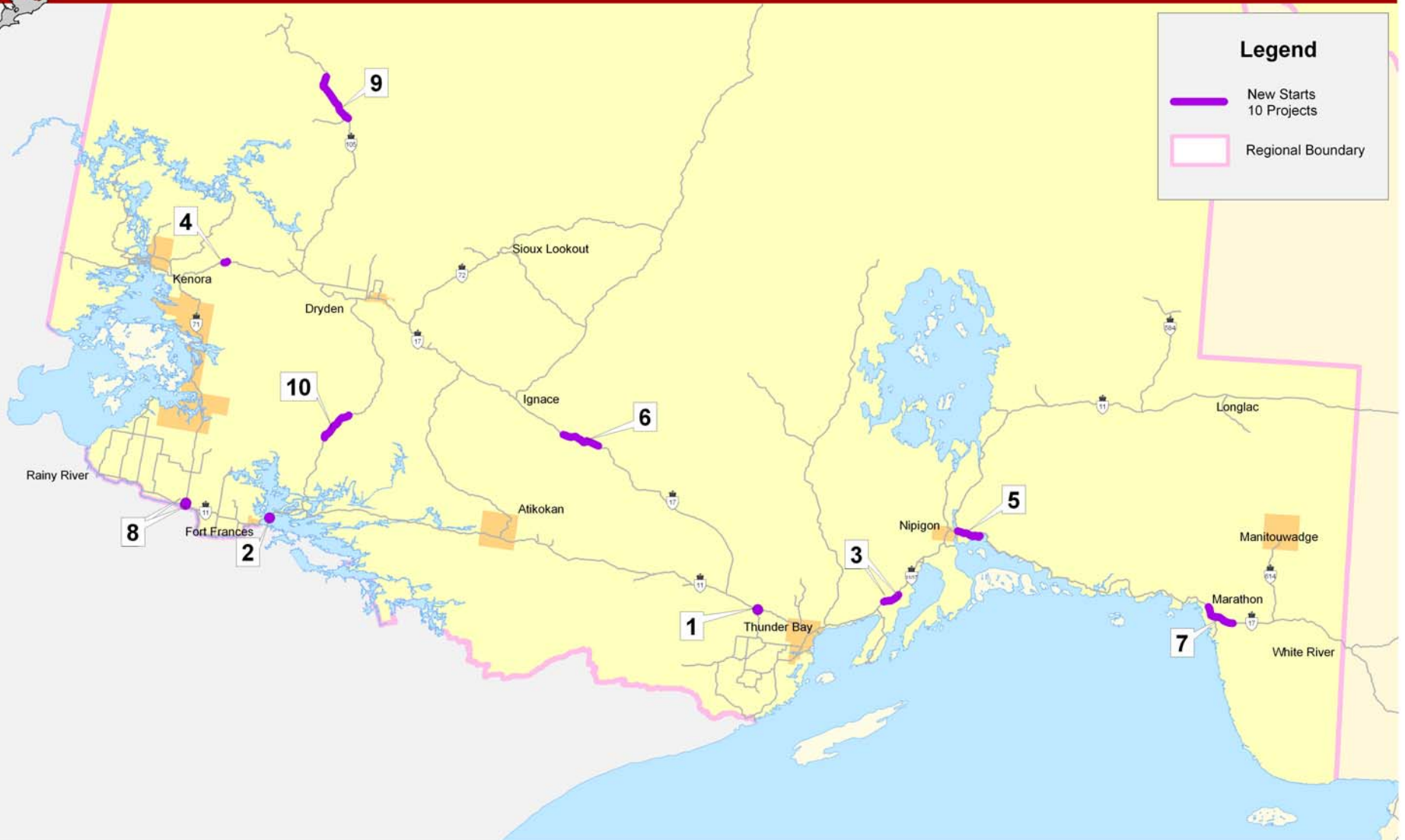
