***Galactosemia and Biotinidase Deficiency Screening delayed,  
new start date is February 28, 2007!***

Due to unforeseen circumstances related to the availability of laboratory supplies and reagents, the Ontario Newborn Screening Laboratory has been forced to delay the start date for screening for galactosemia and biotinidase deficiency (previously announced as February 19, 2007). Screening for galactosemia and biotinidase deficiency will begin on February 28, 2007.
