New Sample Transportation System

1. Your hospital/midwifery practice name
2. Contact person in charge of sample transport at your centre
 - a. Email address for contact person
 - b. Phone number for contact person
3. Average number of births in your centre per year

We plan to begin our rollout of the new system with high-volume centres. Our goal is to completely transition to Purolator by January 31, 2010.
