1. Newborn Screening Ontario Submitter Survey

NSO created this survey to learn more about the current practices in Ontario regarding newborn screening sample collection, result tracking, and parent education. The survey should take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

2. New Time Format on Newborn Screening Reports

The Time of Birth (TOB) and Time of Collection (TOC) of the newborn screening sample has been changed on the newborn screening reports. Time is now reported using the 24 hour clock rather than am/pm as previously reported.
