 - ii. the retailer shall make such adjustments with respect to the consumer to ensure that, over time, the consumer does not pay or receive any global adjustment in respect of the volume of contracted non-Ontario electricity.

- (4) If paragraph 2 of subsection (3) applies,

- (a) the purchasing licensed distributor shall provide to the retailer such information concerning the proportion of electricity distributed to the Class B consumer that is contracted non-Ontario electricity as is necessary for the retailer to make the adjustments required by subparagraph 2 ii of that subsection, within such time limits as are necessary for that purpose; and
- (b) the retailer shall rely on the information provided by the purchasing licensed distributor under clause (a).

Commencement

7. This Regulation comes into force on the later of July 1, 2023 and the day this Regulation is filed.
