Minister

The Minister shall exercise the powers and perform the duties, functions and responsibilities except in respect of rural affairs that had been previously assigned and transferred to the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs under Order in Council O.C. 1185/2022 dated August 29, 2022, and such powers, duties, functions and responsibilities are assigned and transferred to the Minister accordingly.
2. The Minister shall exercise the powers and perform the duties, functions and responsibilities under the *Nutrient Management Act, 2002*, in respect of: the development and approval of nutrient management plans and strategies; registries for nutrient management plans and strategies and other documents; licences and certificates; authorizations; and the delegation of powers and duties pursuant to section 56 of the *Nutrient Management Act, 2002*.
3.
