A Mainstreet Research/Postmedia poll suggests the Liberals' hydro rate cut has left more voters, 25 per cent to be exact, unsure of how to cast their ballot in 2018. Meanwhile, the Toronto Star obtained internal government polling that suggests 82 per cent of Ontarians approve of the Premier's hydro relief package, though 52 per cent aren't sure how she'll pay for it.
