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Delivering Fairness and Choice: Ontario's 2017 Long-Term Energy Plan

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Ontario's electricity system is more than 90% free of greenhouse gas emissions that cause climate change.

We have invested nearly \$70 billion building a clean and reliable energy system that people and businesses across Ontario count on every day.

Through the 2017 Long-Term Energy Plan, Ontario is renewing its commitment to ensuring our electricity is clean, reliable and affordable.

Initiatives include:

- Ontario's Fair Hydro Plan, which lowers electricity bills by 25% on average for residential consumers and as many as half a million small businesses and farms, and will hold increases to the rate of inflation for four years.
- The Ontario Electricity Support Program, which provides monthly credits for people with low incomes.
- A new Affordability Fund, allowing electricity customers who do not qualify for low-income conservation programs to make energy efficiency improvements to their homes.
- Strengthened regulatory powers for the Ontario Energy Board, to provide greater consumer protection for residents living in condos and apartment buildings.
