Since the last Speech from the Throne, your government has been dedicated to reducing electricity costs wherever possible, while maintaining world-leading reliability for all consumers.

It renegotiated the Green Energy Investment Agreement, reducing contract costs by \$3.7 billion.

Extending the operation of the Pickering nuclear generating stations is expected to save customers as much as \$600 million.

The introduction of competitive procurement, as well as annual renewable energy price reviews, have removed a further \$4.2 billion in costs as compared to previous forecasts.

Your government has removed the Debt Retirement Charge from residential electricity bills, made electricity more affordable for low-income families through the Ontario Electricity Support Program, and is investing \$100 million to help homeowners with energy-saving home retrofits.

Despite these efforts, you have continued to face electricity cost increases above the level of inflation.
