Hi all,

Attached please find an updated Energy news release and backgrounders.

Notable changes include:

- Added 'eligible' before 'rural communities' in the release and all backgrounders. It was inaccurate to say 'those living in rural communities would receive even greater reductions'.
- Previously the social program backgrounder included costs broken down by program for the coming fiscal year. These amounts have been removed and instead the total cost over three years has been added at the top (\$2.5B). This ensures consistency with the Premier's statement, news release and technical briefing.
- In the GA backgrounder, a new line has been added to outline the costs associated with the initiative:

"Under current forecasts, the immediate reduction in the GA would be about \$2.5 billion per year on average over the first ten years, with annual interest costs not exceeding \$1.4 billion."

- RRRP has been added to the news release body and quick facts, in order to make sure we had included all elements associated with the \$2.5B cost
