1	The federal government has agreed to give the provinces and territories a 75 per cent share of the tax revenues from the sale of legalized marijuana.
2	The Financial Accountability Officer predicts there will be a \$4 billion deficit in the 2017-18 provincial budget and the government's Fair Hydro Plan will have a toll on the deficit in years to come.
3	A spokesperson for Premier Kathleen Wynne says a statement of claim was filed today in order for the premier to continue with her defamation case against PC Leader Patrick Brown.
4	The TTC is on pace to miss its 2017 ridership target by 10 million trips, causing concern and an expedited growth strategy.
