CBC (Toronto)

- 1) The Ontario Energy Board has approved an energy rate decrease that will begin July 1st as a part of the province's Fair Hydro Plan.
- 2) A Toronto legal clinic is launching a constitutional challenge against the province's Safe Streets Act, arguing that it violates the rights of people who beg for money.
- 3) The SIU are laying additional sexual assault charges against a York Region police officer who is already in jail in connection to another sexual assault charge.
- 4) Toronto police have executed a dozen search warrants against illegal pot shops in the city.
- 5) A Toronto tenant based advocacy group is raising awareness among high rise tenants about the fire code.
- 6) The University of Toronto is holding a black graduation ceremony today. Some have criticized the event as it leads to segregation while the organizers say the event is about community building.
