- 1) Provincial police have charged the driver a dump truck after truck with raised box hits Hwy. 400 overpass yesterday.
- 2) Seven people were taken to hospital overnight after a TTC bus crashed into a hydro pole.
- 3) Hydro bills for residential and small business customers will drop by eight per cent January 1st, as the government begins a rebate of the provincial portion of the HST on electricity. But Premier Kathleen Wynne admits the discount may not be enough for people struggling to pay their hydro bills, and she is hinting at more relief to come.
- 4) Before its last weekend of business, Torontonians have flocked to Honest Ed's to say goodbye.
- 5) Last minute preparations are underway at Nathan Phillip Square for tomorrow night's New Year's eve celebrations.
