Hi Rob,

In follow-up to our conversation, just wanted to flag that I am out of the office and will not be able to attend the DM briefing tomorrow morning. I also understand that only the SoC digital binder is being developed, which has viewership/materials that are slightly different than the normal DM binder.

So, with that in mind, a few notes from LRC/leg planning:

- The **May 3rd CAB agenda** looks like it has two policy items from MOHLTC that are part of a leg bundle that is tracking for intro & pass in Fall 2017 (copying Rob)
 - o It should be attached to the digital binder, but including a PDF copy of the **leg tracker** as FYI
- All items on the **May 1st LRC agenda** are tracking for LRC-CAB approval.
 - o We are still waiting for materials for Tab 1 (Building Code) in the hopes that it can be included in Thursday's re-publication
 - o The second item recommended for discussion is an MOECC proclamation for water quality trading which also signals potential future regulations. Karen and her team can give the details; however, the intent is for the Minister (i.e. Chair) to give a bit more detail into the development of future regulations, especially since the enabling provisions are from a 2008 Act. I've been in touch with the Chair's office and they have not raised any concerns.
- Normally, we would include earlier drafts of the LRC agendas at the DM briefing, which would not go in the SoC binders. The first version of the **May 15th LRC agenda** is attached FYI, and the Deputy may note it is a packed/meaty agenda with the final elements of the Spring leg agenda.
 - o While it is still early in the agenda process, if there are any questions on the items please let me know.
