Here's what they been able to pull together. The first document is a year-by-year summary of government bills since 2013. The Bills/Acts that have provisions that have not yet been proclaimed are highlighted in grey (the yellow highlights where the whole bill, or a significant portion of it, has not yet been proclaimed). This is an internal document.

The second is a detailed list of provisions (only since 2013) that haven't been proclaimed. This is from the publicly available legislative tables list (with some work anyone could put this together using that table). Unfortunately, since there are so many it would take quite a while to pull together descriptions of each unproclaimed provision. I can get people started on that if you need it, but would probably take a couple days to sort through each individual Act.

Hope that helps. Let me know if you have any questions.

Craig – I was right. There is a table available publicly that outlines all the Acts and the in force dates. Any Act or section of an Act that doesn't have a date next to it is unproclaimed.
