CFTO (Toronto)

Opposition parties pressed the Ontario government to explain the source of the revenue that will allow for a hydro rebate and the creation of 100,000 new spaces.

CJOH (Ottawa)

A private hospital in the Cayman Islands is marketing to Canadians who are tired of waiting for surgeries. 52,500 Canadians left the country in 2014 for healthcare reasons. Some countries have complications linked to their surgeries.

MCTV (Sudbury)

Ontario's Energy Minister Glenn Thibeault was in Sudbury today talking about electricity prices. Thibeault and the Wynne government have announced they will be offering people who qualify an 8-per-cent rebate on their hydro bills.

The 8-per-cent hydro rebate was one of the main focal points of yesterday's new throne speech at Queen's Park. It is said to reflect the government's new and refocused priority list.

Many home owners are reacting to the news of the hydro rebates and calculating how it will affect their bills and whether they will benefit.

It looks as though the deal for a Chinese company to build a plant in Timmins is just about done. The mayor is back from a third trip to China with a signed agreement which should mean job creation for the community.

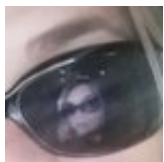

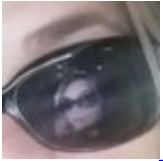
