Mike – on market renewal as Karen noted, the ministry is not currently tracking anything for “approval”/minuting in August. That said, the August submission will have a focus on rates and Market renewal is a tool we have, and have said publicly, that would assist with rates so it could be a submission where we look to minute specifics about market renewal.

We did minute market renewal as part of the fair hydro plan policy approval (then called rate mitigation) in March: “Directing Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) – Modernize Ontario’s electricity market through electricity Market Renewal initiatives”. It would be relatively simple (says me) to minute further details around market renewal through a minute, such as a framework, priorities we’d want IESO to align with, etc. The directives that give IESO and OEB their marching order (more or less) are expected to come to Cabinet sometime in September so minuting market renewal in August is still enough time to work into the directives

Hi Dan, Mike,

In follow-up to yesterday’s briefing from the Ministry of Energy on the 2017 LTEP policy initiatives, please find attached the final CBN for Cabinet next week. This reflects all input from Energy as well as partner ministries, including MOECC and TBS.

A couple of things to flag:

- Implementation directives to the IESO and OEB were originally going to include direction to deliver implementation plans by December 31, 2017. The ministry is now recommending “as soon as possible” in the event that the LTEP and directives are delayed. This gives some wiggle room but they communicated to us that they intend to keep to the end of 2017 as closely as possible. Approximately 3 months is required for the agencies to develop their plans once they receive the implementation directives.
- IESO Market Renewal – Energy has not confirmed whether they will include language regarding market renewal in the August 31 submission. They are seeking clarity from their MO and will let us know as soon as possible. Nothing in this submission precludes them moving forward with language on market renewal in the next submission.
