2A. Is the 25% cap new? What if that doesn't get us to full repayment by 2048?

2A i. I see OEB is included for expanded powers. Hadn't appreciated we were adjusting their mandate and legislation too. That might be sensitive. Do we address that in the note?

3A i. Why do we say "some of" the highest distribution rates? Aren't these the highest? And isn't the point to capture all the ones over the threshold, which by default makes them the highest? To

say some begs question of how we're selecting them if not just by price.
