Please find attached a draft TB Assessment Note for the OPG Business Plan item.

We would like to highlight TB's recommendation regarding the request to delegate international travel approval to the OPG's CEO. We are seeking clarification from TB staff, but this appears to suggest that they are denying the request and asking OPG to work with ENE / TBS on a strategy using existing authorities. The note also appears to suggest that the Ministry did not provide sufficient information. As you may recall, we responded earlier this week with a package of additional information.
