

## Premier's Bill Rebate NR

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You'll recall the awkward rural rebate sentence. See green highlighted in attached and below for reference. Okay to send to MO?

About five million consumers across Ontario would ~~further~~ benefit from the proposed legislation and additional measures as it would provide an on-bill rebate ~~for equal to of~~ eight per cent on the amount before tax, an average savings of about \$130 annually or \$11 each month. Proposed regulatory amendments would mean Rural consumers would receive an additional benefit from decreasing rural delivery charges. ~~for eligible~~ Eligible customers would receive a combined total benefit of ~~by~~ an average of \$540 a year or \$45 each month.
