- **The 2017 Long-Term Energy Plan (LTEP), *Delivering Fairness and Choice*, focusses on energy affordability, innovation and customer choice.**
- **Nearly \$70 billion has been invested in Ontario's electricity system since 2003 to ensure it is clean and reliable.**
- **As of July 1, 2017, Ontario's Fair Hydro Plan reduced electricity bills by 25 per cent on average for residential consumers and as many as half a million small businesses and farms across the province. As part of the plan, any increases to bills will be held to the rate of inflation for four years.**
- **We recognize the importance of electricity prices for business. Maintaining competitiveness with respect to energy costs is a top government priority.**
- **Existing initiatives available to small and medium-sized businesses to help them manage their electricity costs include the saveONenergy for Business conservation program.**
