You asked Lauren for the following information regarding the MOHLTC's request for KMs/Key Messaging to respond to an article in the Barrie Examiner (original attached)

Q&A Response

Q. Do hospitals qualify for ICI, and if not, do some qualify for the 8% rebate?

A. Currently hospitals with average monthly peak demand greater than 5 MW qualify for the Industrial Conservation Initiative (ICI).

Hospitals with average monthly peak demand greater than 1 MW and less than 5 MW will qualify under the expanded ICI.

Hospitals will likely not qualify for the 8% rebate given that it is available to Regulated Price Plan eligible electricity consumers only (i.e., residential and small commercial electricity consumers under 250,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh)).

Note: It is likely that a number of larger hospitals will be able to participate in the expanded ICI because they are likely to have average monthly peak demand greater than 1 MW.
