Hi Deputy,

Please find attached a draft of the document explaining the OFHP motions in plain language. Carolyn noted that this is still draft, as she following up on a few definitions, and she recommends not to not to discuss this document at the table at the larger group tomorrow. Two reasons for this: first, she wants to make sure that the fair allocation formula works for Tim, before showing it more broadly. Second, this document will be our instructions to Legislative Counsel for drafting the motions and is solicitor-client privileged. Keeping it to ourselves preserves that privilege, while sharing waives that privilege. She does intend to share the draft motions once we get them back from Leg Counsel (in consultation form) with the accountants, OPG, IESO, OEB and the lawyers to the dealers to make sure they are ok with the proposed amendments (expected to happen on Tuesday).

Ok to advise MO that we will not be walking this document in tomorrow?
