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>> Hello Deputy,

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>> I just wanted to let you know that Energy Storage Canada is proposing a very simple and streamlined solution to the "regulatory barrier to storage" that the 2013 LTEP indicates will be removed. We have proposed to that we simply exempt licensed wholesale storage providers (loading off peak and discharging on peak or as required by IESO) from non-energy, distribution and uplift charges through REG 166/99 while the Act and the Regs are open to incorporate the Ontario Fair Hydro Plan. It is much more efficient and effective than a reg by reg and market rule and code exemption and puts storage in a position where it is not being disadvantaged and treated like a consuming load instead of a unique flexibility asset. I hope that you will support us in achieving this fix to the last of the 3 LTEP commitments outstanding for storage. Many thanks,
