Hi Deputy,

I received the updated bullet regarding rural rates from SNAP for the electricity pricing deck. Below and attached on slide 39 is the proposed bullet relating to shifting costs within the sector.

- **Between 2014 and 2016, a low-density rural residential customer using 750 kWh per month saw a distribution charge increase of almost \$13 per month, or 20%. In the same period, an urban customer use 750 kWh per month saw a distribution charge decrease of about \$1.40 per month, or -3.8%.**
